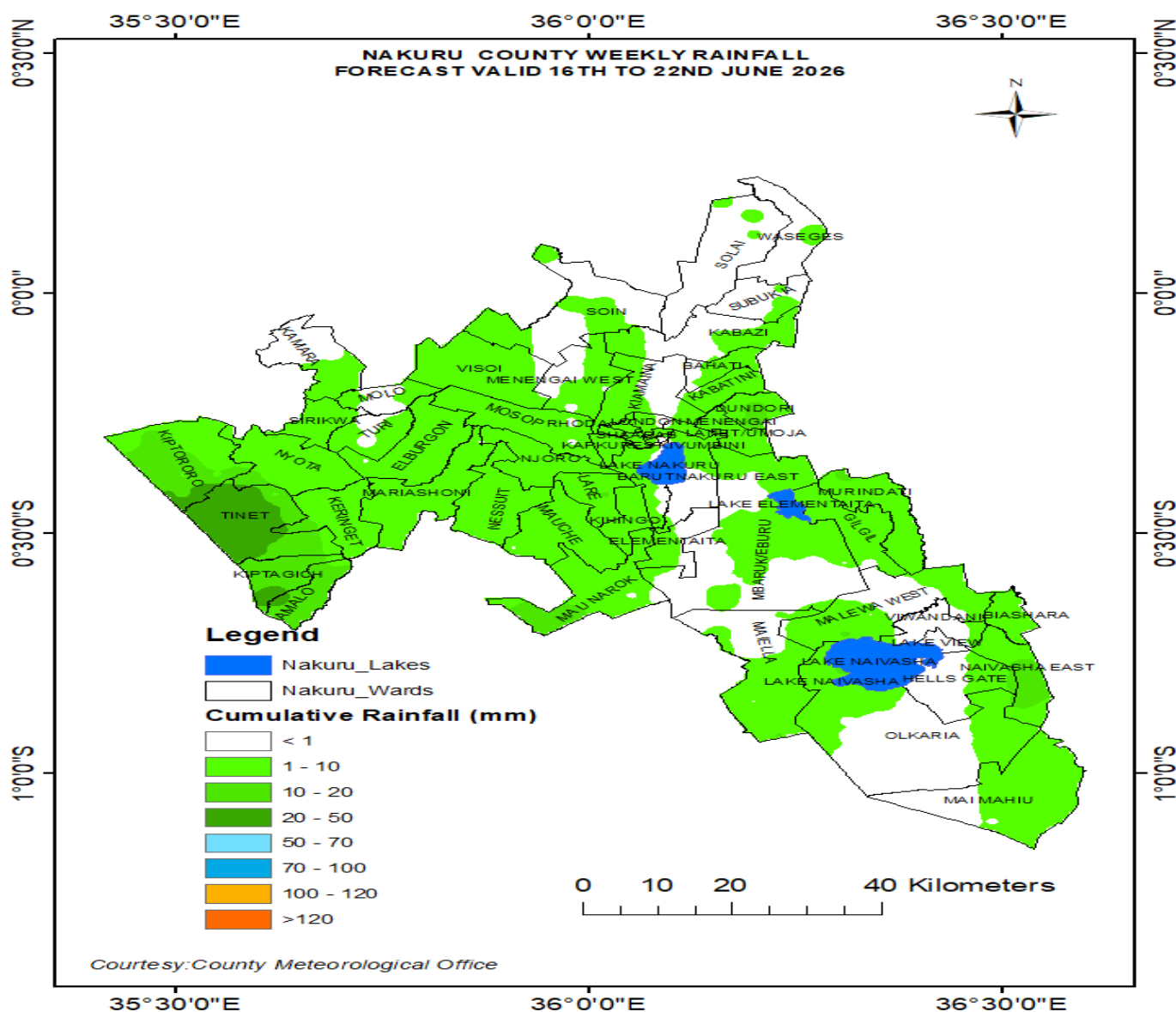

Summary

- Figure1 above shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nakuru county is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 16th to Monday 22nd June 2026 (Refer to the Figure legend/key for details of forecasted amounts).
- Detailed forecast in the climatic zone tables 1-3 above indicates that parts of Kiptororo, Tinet and Kiptagich wards are projected to receive the highest cumulative weekly rainfall of between 50mm and 70mm, Parts of Kamara, Molo, Turi, Soin, Menengai west, Kabazi, Kiamaina, Solai, Wasenges, Subukia, Nakuru east, Baruti, Mbaruk/Emburu, Elementaita, Maiela, Malewa west, Hells gate, Olkaria and Mai Mahiu wards are projected to receive minimal amounts of less than 1mm of rainfall cumulatively for the week while the rest of wards will receive between 1mm and 20mm of rainfall cumulatively for the week.
- Overall, majority of the wards are projected to receive morning rains and afternoon and/or night showers over few places during the forecast period. Areas over large water bodies like lakes Nakuru and Naivasha (and their environs which includes the City and Naivasha town) may occasionally experience afternoon showers over few to several places due to local climatological effects.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Partly cloudy conditions with rains over few places in the morning hours.
- Showers over few to several places in the afternoon/evening.
- Partly cloudy night conditions with showers expected during the forecast period.

Advice to farmers from the Ministry & Department of Agriculture:

Highly consider to always consult your local agricultural extension officer for advice on how to plan your farming activities in light of this forecast.
