LAIKIPIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 16 – 22 JUNE, 2026

SUMMARY

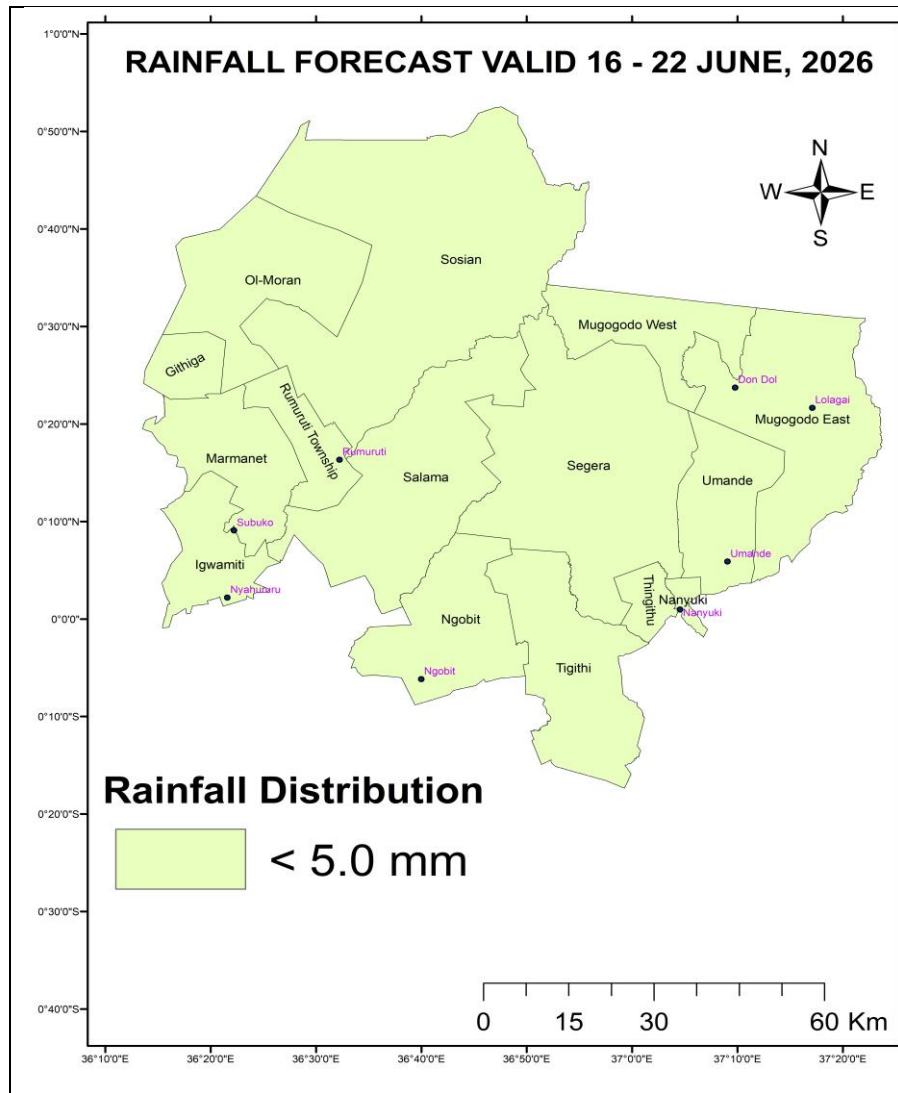
Weather Forecast for 16 - 22 June, 2026 indicates;

- Mainly warm and dry conditions expected over most places
- Generally Cloudy/Sunny intervals are likely to prevail over most places with chances of isolated showers over few places in the afternoon.
- The Maximum day time temperatures are expected rise, ranging between 25 – 32°C while the Minimum night time temperatures are likely to range 05 - 17°C
- Minimum Temperatures below 10.0°C are likely around Nyahururu, Marmanet and the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya

Weather review 09 - 15 June, 2026

- Light amounts of rainfall were recorded in Lokusero, Dol Dol, Kinamba and a few other areas
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased over most places*
- The day time maximum temperatures increased over most Places while the night time minimum temperatures varied from place to place

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days (16 - 22 June, 2026)



Mainly sunny and dry conditions are expected to prevail over most places

Cloudy/Sunny conditions in the morning giving way to short sunny intervals with light showers mainly over the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya
