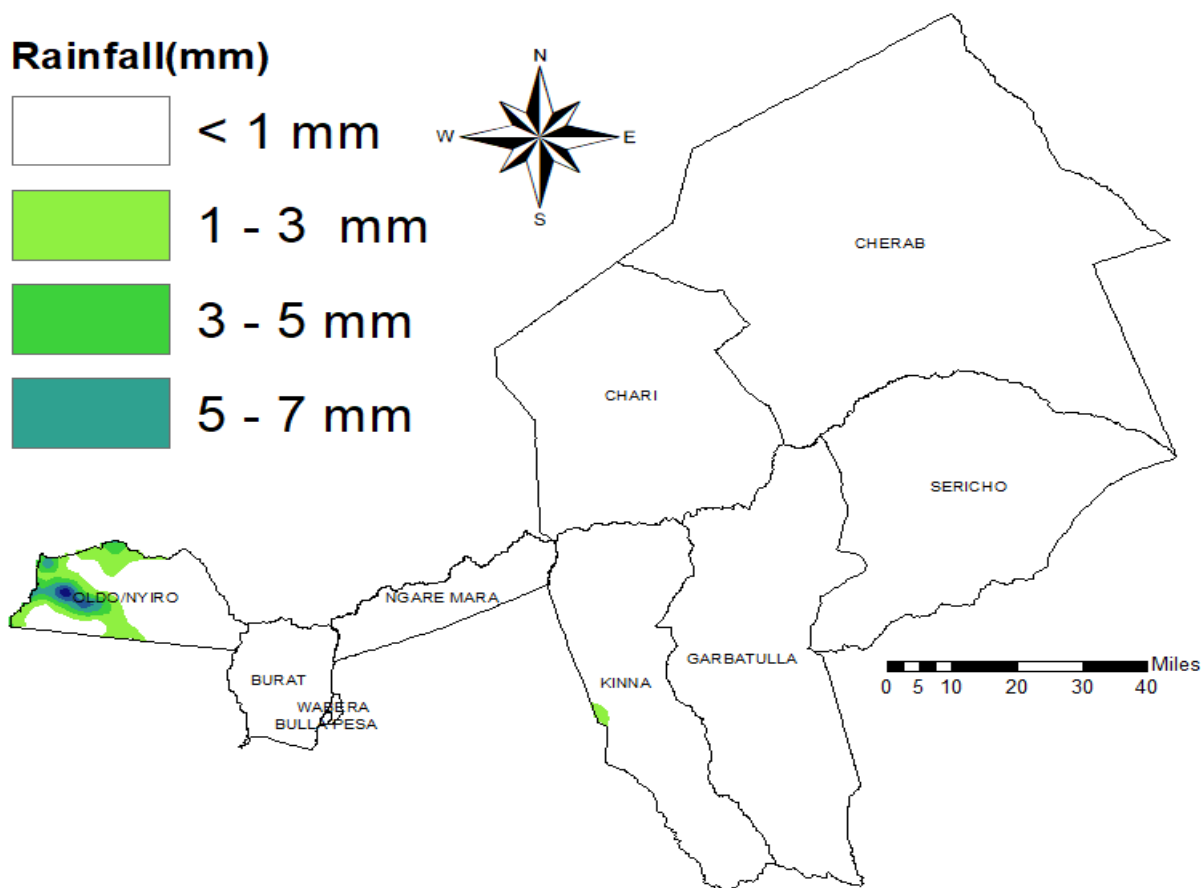
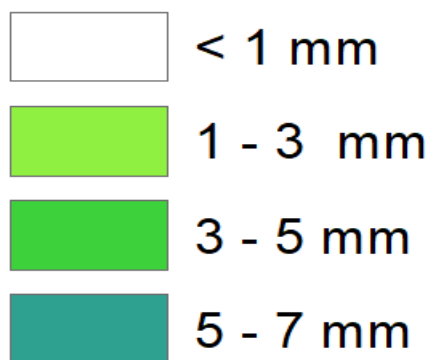
ISIOLO COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Isiolo County Weather Outlook (23rd – 29th June 2026)

Most parts of Isiolo County are expected to remain generally dry during the forecast period of **23rd – 29th June 2026**. Little or no rainfall is expected across most areas, although isolated light showers may occur over a few western locations around Oldonyiro and areas bordering Laikipia County. Cool mornings and nights are expected in western parts of the county, while daytime conditions will remain warm to hot across the eastern and northeastern lowlands. Moderate to strong winds are likely to persist across much of the county, occasionally generating dusty conditions in open areas.

1. Isiolo Central Sub-County (Isiolo Town, Burat, Oldonyiro)

Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, and Bulapesa are expected to experience predominantly sunny and dry conditions throughout the forecast period. Oldonyiro and adjacent western areas may receive isolated light showers, though rainfall amounts are expected to remain minimal.

Wind Forecast

- Moderate winds of approximately 12–25 knots are expected across most areas.
- Occasional stronger gusts may occur over open plains and exposed areas during afternoon hours.

2. Garbatulla Sub-County (Garbatulla, Kinna, Sericho)

Garbatulla, Kinna, and Sericho are expected to remain largely dry with sunny intervals and occasional cloud cover. Continued dry conditions may contribute to gradual deterioration of pasture and browse resources in some areas, particularly away from permanent water sources.

Wind Forecast

- Moderate to strong winds ranging between 15–30 knots are expected.
- Dusty conditions may occur occasionally, especially during the afternoons.

3. Merti Sub-County (Merti, Bulesa, Kom)

Dry and mostly sunny weather is expected to prevail across Merti, Bulesa, Kom, and surrounding areas. No significant rainfall is anticipated during the forecast period.

Wind Forecast

- Moderate to strong winds of approximately 15–30 knots are expected, particularly over exposed dry surfaces.

4. Ngaremara Areas

Ngaremara and surrounding locations are expected to remain generally dry. A few isolated locations may experience brief light showers, but rainfall totals are expected to be negligible.

Wind Forecast

- Moderate winds of around 15–25 knots are expected.
- Occasional stronger gusts may be experienced in open areas.

5. Kinna & Ewaso Nyiro Belt

Most parts of Kinna and the Ewaso Nyiro belt are expected to remain dry throughout the forecast period. Riverine areas may experience occasional cloudiness, but significant rainfall is not anticipated.

Wind Forecast

- Winds ranging between 15–28 knots are expected across the riverine corridor and adjacent dry plains.

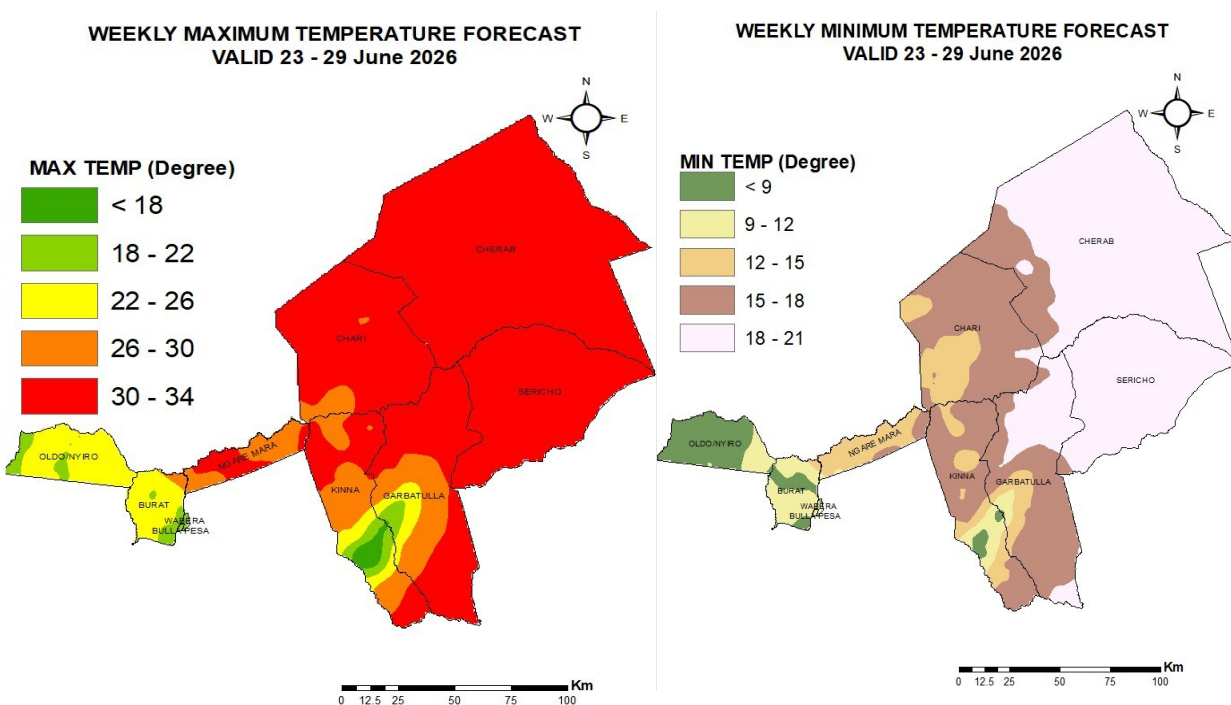
6. Sericho & Cherab Areas

Sericho, Cherab, and the eastern parts of the county are expected to remain hot, sunny, and dry throughout the forecast period. No significant rainfall is expected.

Wind Forecast

- Strong winds of around 20–32 knots are expected, particularly during afternoon hours.
- Occasional blowing dust and temporary reductions in visibility may occur in exposed locations.

Temperature Outlook



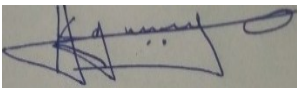
- The highest daytime temperatures are expected over the eastern and northeastern lowlands, including Sericho, Cherab, Garbatulla, and parts of Merti, where temperatures may range between **35°C and 38°C**.
- Relatively cooler conditions are expected around Oldonyiro and western areas influenced by the Mt. Kenya highlands, with daytime temperatures ranging between **24°C and 29°C**.
- Isiolo Town, Burat, Ngaremara, and Kinna are expected to experience daytime temperatures ranging between **30°C and 34°C**.

- Night-time temperatures are expected to range between **15°C and 20°C** in western areas and **20°C to 24°C** across the eastern lowlands.

Advisory

- Livestock keepers are advised to continue monitoring water availability and grazing conditions as dry weather persists.
- Residents in areas prone to dust should take necessary precautions, particularly during periods of strong winds.
- Farmers in irrigated areas are encouraged to utilize available water resources efficiently due to the continued dry conditions.
