



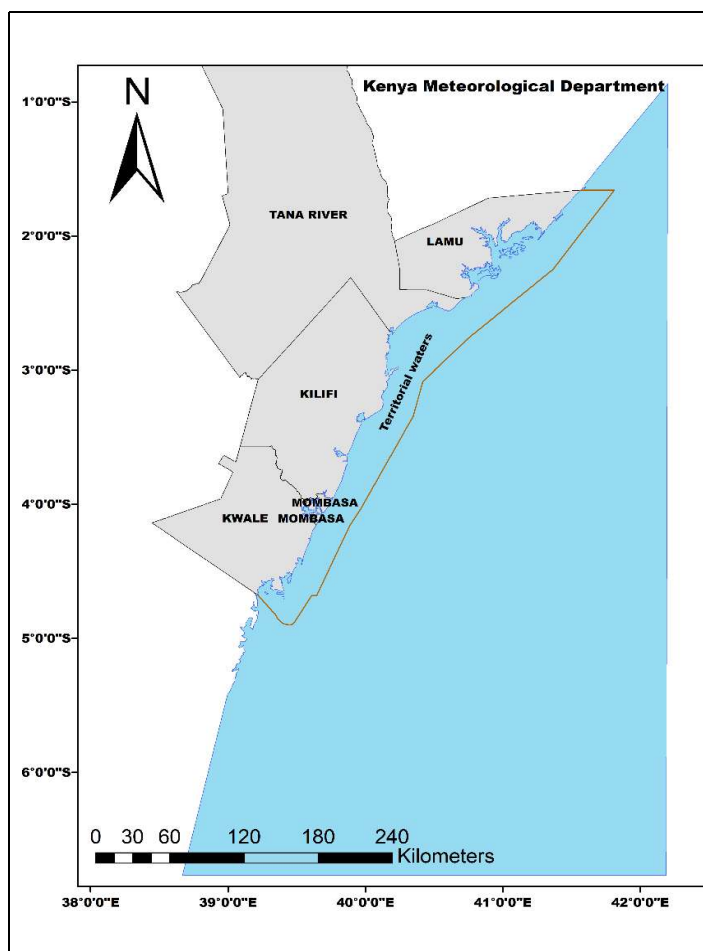

DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 25th June, 2026

Valid: 0000 EAT on 26th June, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 27th June, 2026.



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Moderate to strong S to SSW (14-24 knots) with choppy seas. ESE to SE waves of 5-7 ft (1.5-2.1 m) with moderate to large short period waves of (8 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Moderate to strong SSE to S (17-26 knots) with choppy seas. ESE to SE waves of 5-8 ft (1.5-2.4 m) with moderate to large short period waves of (7-8 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: SSW 15 to 21 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Moderate to strong SSW winds with choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 18 to 24 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 5 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong SSE winds with choppy seas. Moderate short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:29AM** and sunset: **6:22PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **1:43AM;2.45m, 1:59PM;3.07m**
- Low Tide: **7:31AM;1.18m, 8:39PM;0.94m**

- Morning Waves: ESE 6 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Moderate to strong SSW winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 17 to 24 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:27AM** and sunset: **6:20PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **1:49AM;2.29m, 2:06PM;2.96m**
- Low Tide: **7:26AM;1.12m, 8:40PM;0.95m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: S 15 to 24 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 7 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 18 to 26 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 8 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:26AM** and Sunset: **6:21PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **1:44AM;2.05m, 1:56PM;2.66m**
- Low Tide: **7:21AM;10m, 8:34PM;0.76m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 14 to 24 knots.
- Morning Waves: SE 7 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 17 to 26 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 7 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Large short period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:19AM** and Sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **00:36AM;1.91m, 1:04PM;2.49m**
- Low Tide: **6:20AM;0.98m, 7:47PM;0.86m**

Advisory

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 1.5 m- 2.4 m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Take caution.
- Gentle to fresh breeze of 14-26 knots expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Conditions are dangerous for marine operations.**

4.1 – 5.5 m (≈ 12.3 – 16.5 ft)	Very Rough	Warning in place and marine activities on hold

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
