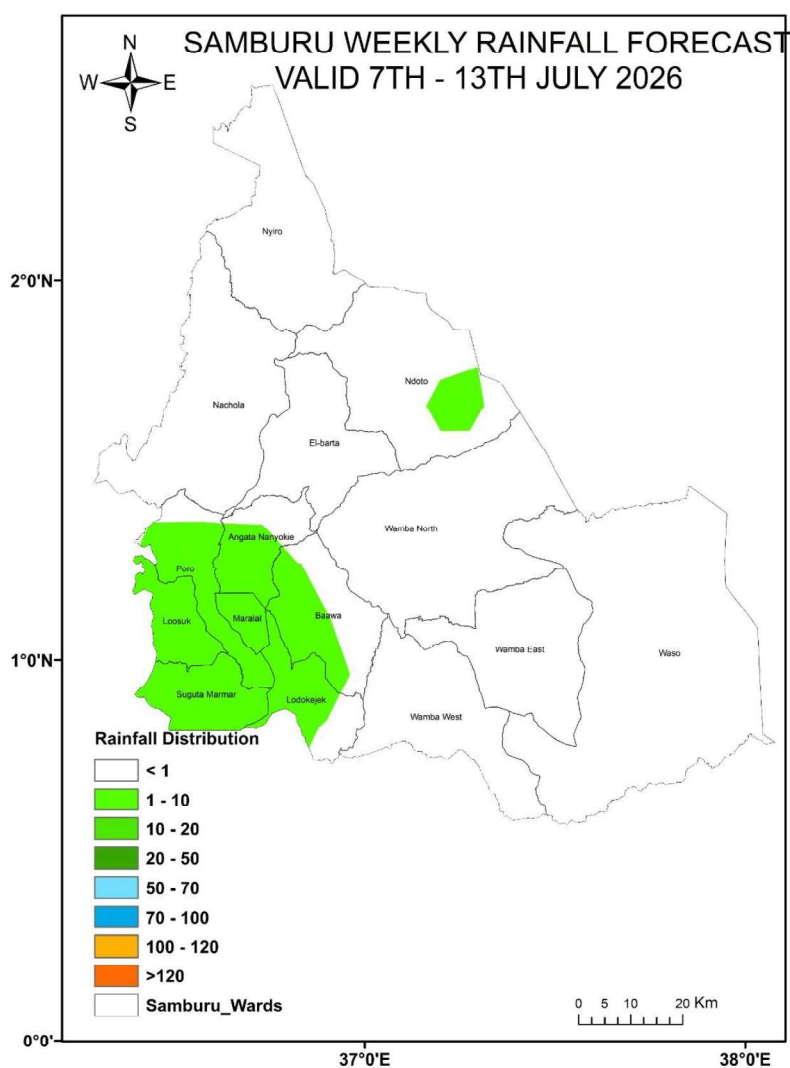
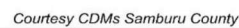
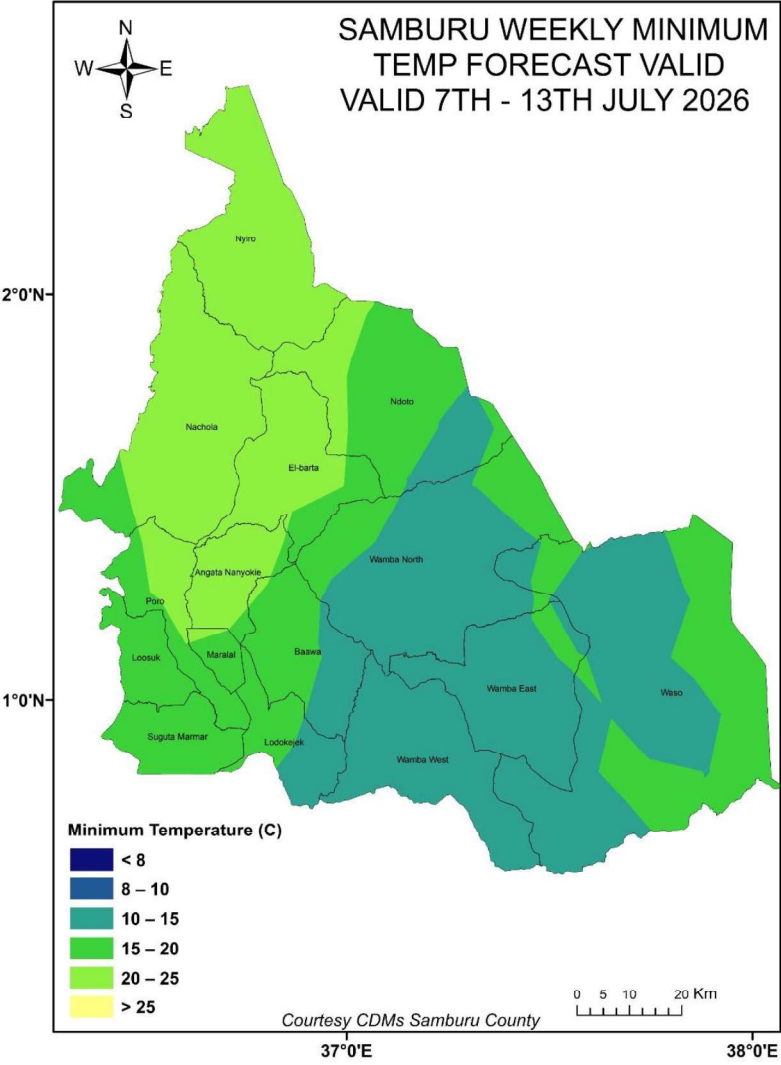

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- ❖ The above Figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 7th July to 13th July, 2026. Mainly sunny intervals are expected during the day with partly cloudy nights in the forecast period.
- ❖ Occasional rains are expected in Maralal, Loosuk, Suguta Marmar, and parts of Baawa, Poro Lodokejek and Angata Nanyokie
- ❖ Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period. Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25.0 °C and 35.0 °C as shown in Figure 2.
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0 °C and 20.0 °C as shown in Figure 3.
- ❖ The weather outlook for the week of 14th July to 20th July 2026, Samburu County is likely to experience Dry weather conditions over several places.
