EMBU WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 7TH TO 13TH JULY 2026

SUMMARY:

- Generally intermittent cold and cloudy mornings ,breaking into sunny intervals in the afternoon with occasional rains expected in few places (highgrounds) in most of forecast period in Manyatta and Runyenjes sub-counties.
- Dry and cloudy conditions in the morning breaking in sunny intervals in the afternoon expected in Mbeere south and mbeere north sub-counties in most of the forecast period.
- Some eastern parts of Evurore, Muminji , Muvuria, Kiembere and Makima wards are expected to remain dry in most of the forecast period.
- Cloudy with occasional light rains (over a few places) is expected during nights in most parts of the county
