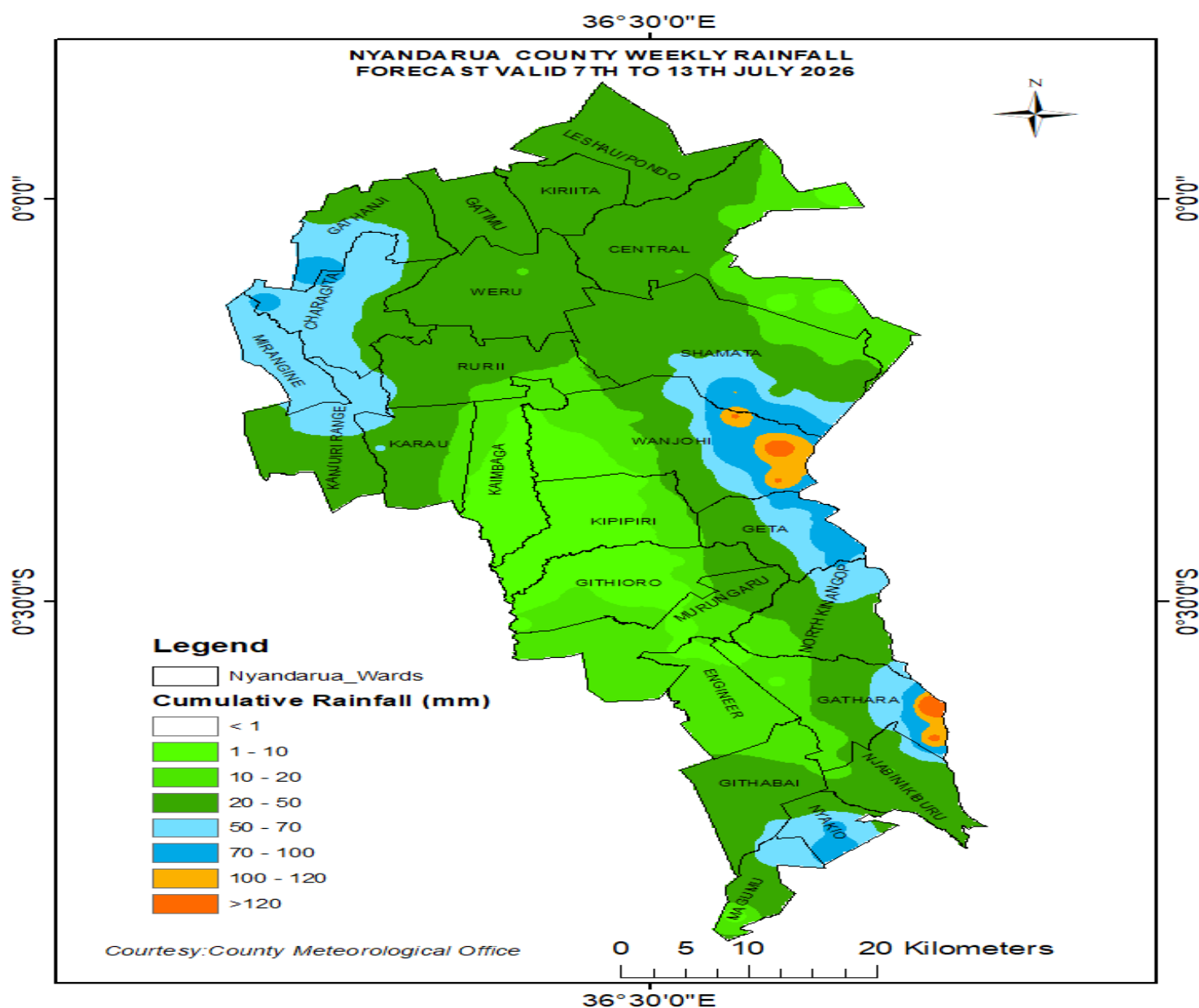

Summary:

The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nyandarua county is forecasted to receive from Tuesday 7th to Monday 13th July 2026 (Refer to the legend/key for details on forecasted amounts).

- Parts of Mirangine, Charagita, Geta, Gathanji, Shamata, Wanjohi, North Kinangop, Karau, Rurii, Kanjuiri/Range, Githabai, Magumu, Nyakio and Njabini/Kiburu are projected to receive the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amounts of between 50mm and 70mm with some pockets within Wanjohi and Gathara wards likely to receive between 100mm and 120mm cumulatively for the week.
- The rest of the wards are projected to receive between 1mm and 50mm cumulatively for the week.
