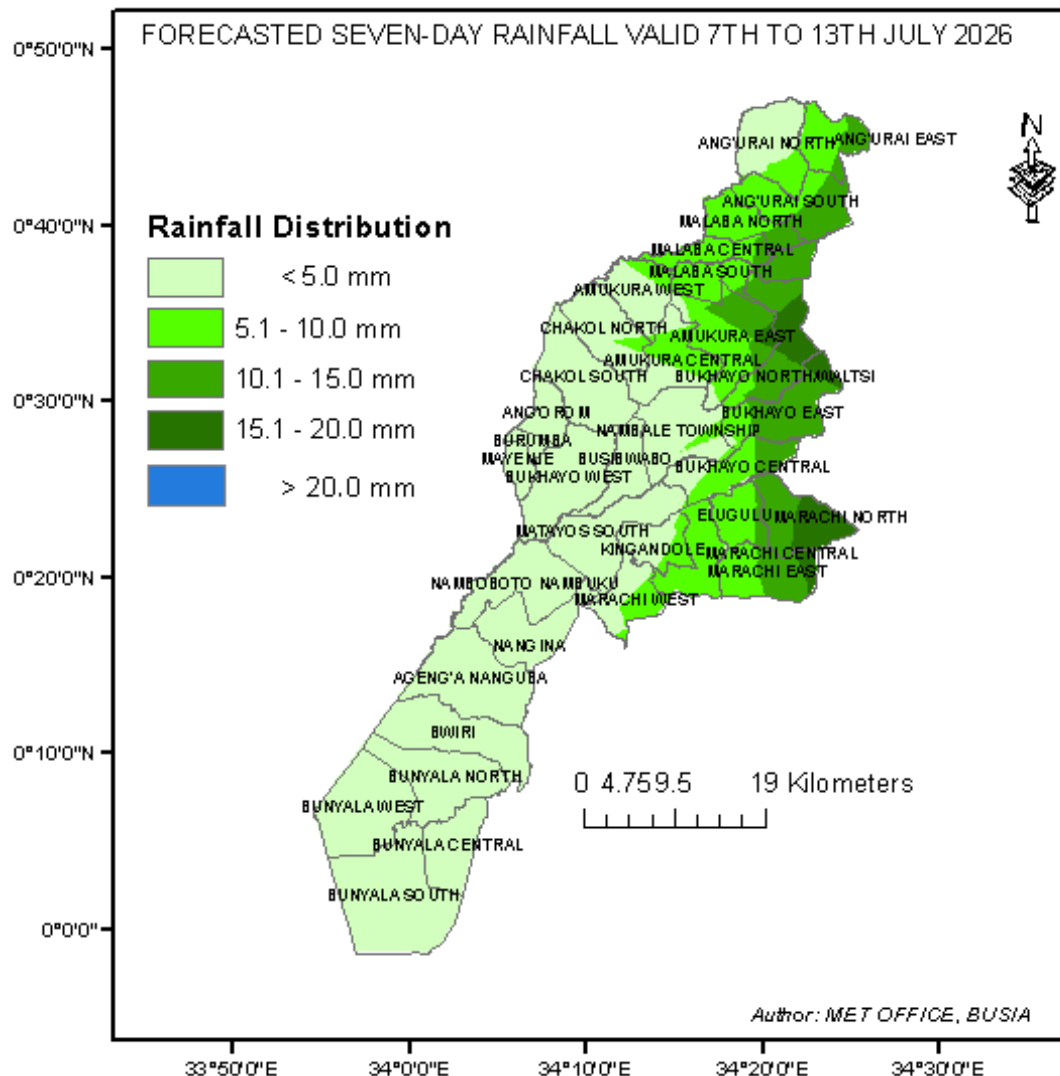

BUSIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

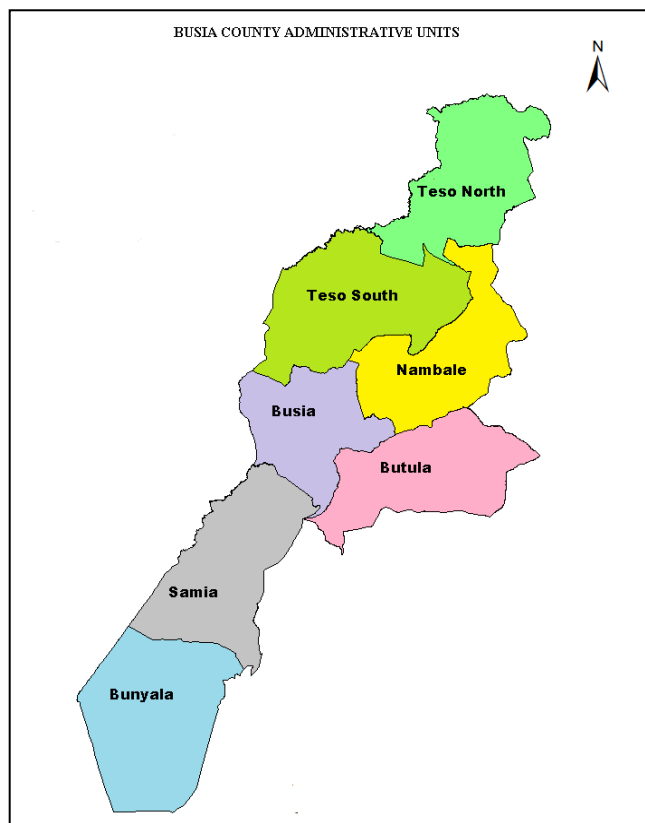


Period of forecast: Tuesday 7th July 2026 to Monday 13th July 2026

Date of issue: Monday 6th July 2026 Summary

Mornings will be mainly dry, but a few parts of northern Busia County are likely to experience light rain in the afternoon. Southern parts of the county will be drier. Nights will be mostly dry, but localised moderate rain is expected in northern sub-counties on Saturday and Sunday.

Daytime temperatures are expected to be almost the same compared to last week, ranging between 26°C and 31°C, while nighttime lows are expected to be between 17°C and 19°C.

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

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- Eastern parts of Butula, Nambale, Teso South and Teso North Sub Counties are likely to have more rainfall than the rest of the County.
- Harvest rainwater and store it safely for future use.
- If you hear thunder or see lightning, find shelter inside a building. Stay away from windows and doors.
- Protect your animals from cold rain and the risk of lightning strikes, strong wind or hail by bringing them indoors when it rains.
- Mulch your farms to retain moisture among growing plants. Seek further guidance from agriculture extension officers in your ward on farm activities.
