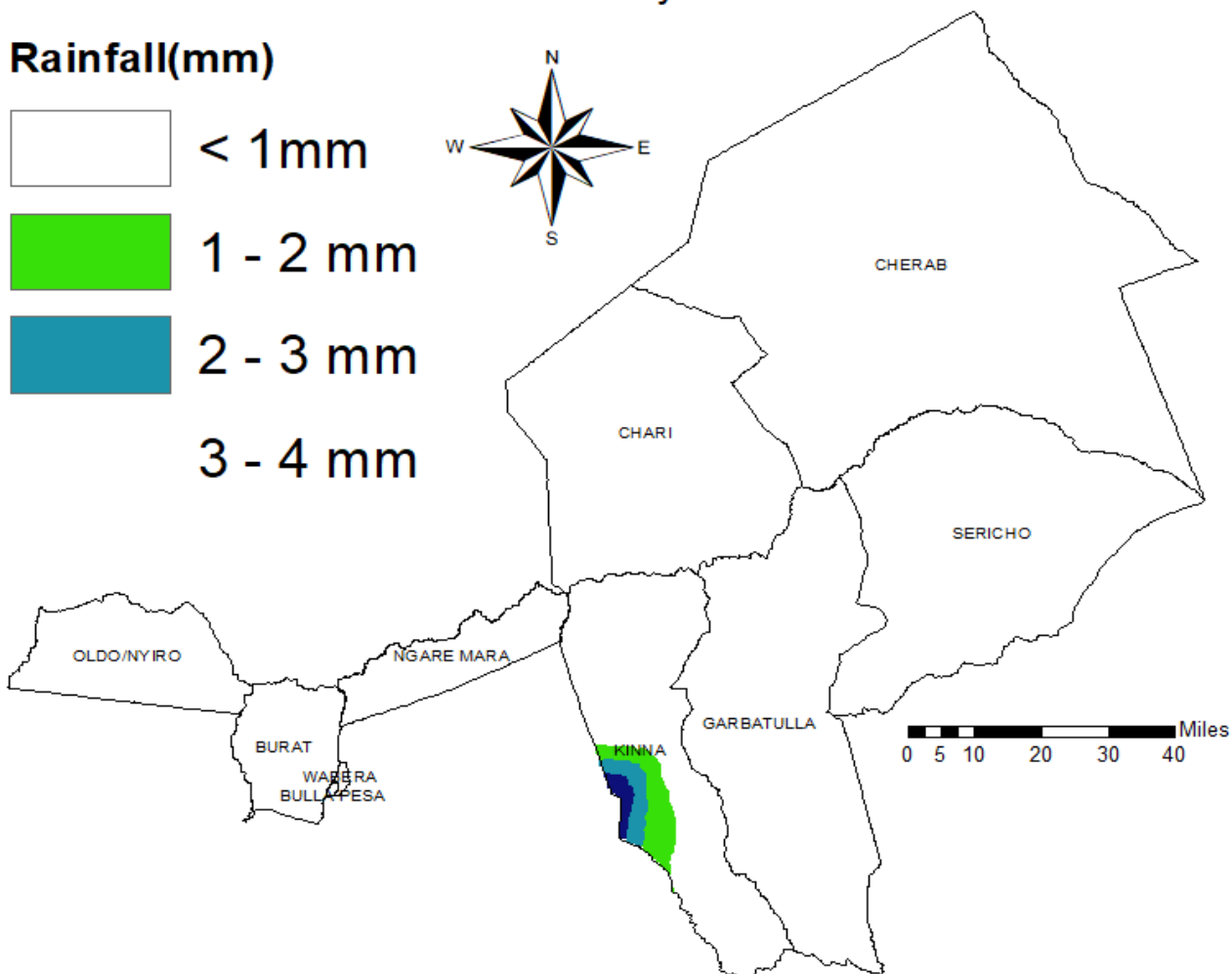
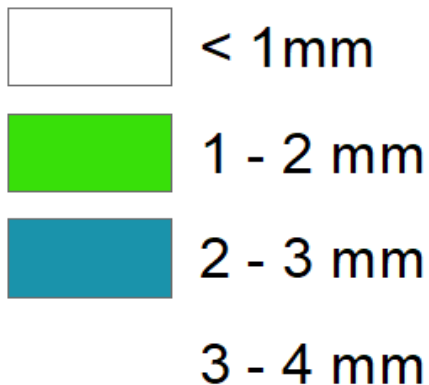
ISIOLO COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Isiolo County Weather Outlook 7th to 13th July 2026

Most parts of Isiolo County are expected to remain generally dry during the forecast period of 7th to 13th July 2026, as the cool dry season continues to dominate across northern and eastern Kenya. No significant rainfall is expected across most parts of the county. However, isolated light showers may occur over a few western areas around Oldonyiro and locations bordering Laikipia County, particularly during the late afternoon and evening hours. Cool mornings and nights are expected in the western highland-influenced areas, while warm to hot daytime temperatures will persist across the eastern, central, and northeastern parts of the county. Moderate to occasionally strong winds are expected to continue throughout the week, with localized dusty conditions likely over exposed and open areas.

1. Isiolo Central Sub-County (Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, Bulapesa, Oldonyiro)

Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, Bulapesa, and surrounding areas are expected to remain predominantly sunny and dry throughout the forecast period. Oldonyiro and neighboring western areas may experience isolated light showers of less than 3 mm, although rainfall is expected to remain localized and brief.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of approximately 12–25 knots are expected across most areas.

Occasional gusty winds may develop during the afternoons, particularly over open plains and along major road corridors.

2. Garbatulla Sub-County (Garbatulla, Kinna, Sericho)

Garbatulla, Kinna, and surrounding settlements are expected to remain largely dry, with sunny conditions and occasional cloud cover. Continued dry weather is likely to maintain pressure on pasture and browse resources, particularly in areas far from permanent water sources.

Wind Forecast

Moderate to strong winds ranging between 15–30 knots are expected.

Dusty conditions may develop during afternoon hours, especially over open rangelands.

3. Merti Sub-County (Merti, Bulesa, Kom)

Dry and mostly sunny weather is expected to prevail across Merti, Bulesa, Kom, and surrounding areas throughout the forecast period. No significant rainfall is anticipated.

Wind Forecast

Moderate to strong winds of approximately 15–30 knots are expected.

Localized dust lifting is likely over exposed dry surfaces.

4. Ngaremara Areas

Ngaremara and neighboring locations are expected to remain generally dry. Afternoon cloud build-up may occur on a few days, but rainfall is unlikely, and any showers that develop are expected to be isolated and light.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of around 15–25 knots are expected.

Occasional stronger gusts may occur in open areas.

5. Kinna & Ewaso Nyiro Belt

Most parts of Kinna and the Ewaso Nyiro River corridor are expected to remain dry during the forecast period. Riverine areas may experience occasional afternoon cloudiness, but no significant rainfall is expected.

Wind Forecast

Winds ranging between 15–28 knots are expected along the river corridor and adjacent plains. Localized dust may occur in dry areas away from the river.

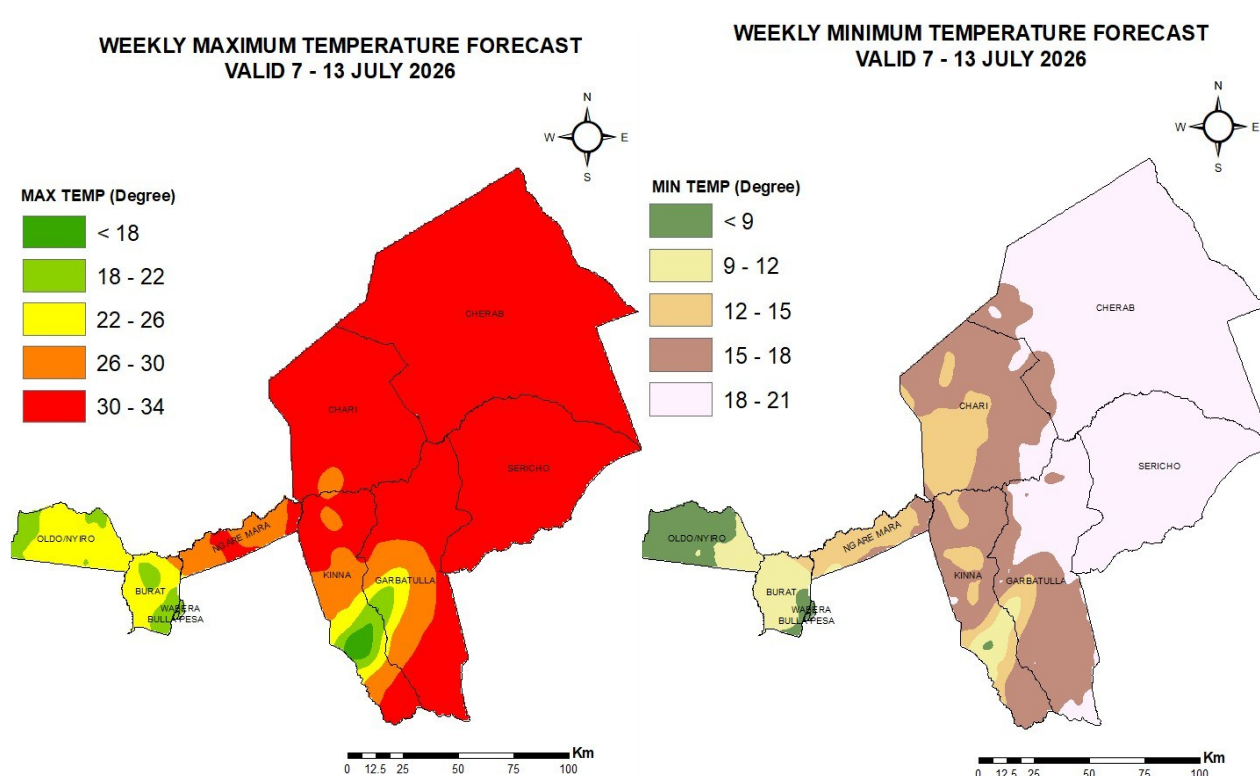
6. Sericho & Cherab Areas

Sericho, Cherab, and the eastern parts of the county are expected to remain hot, sunny, and dry throughout the forecast period. No significant rainfall is expected.

Wind Forecast

Strong winds of approximately 20–32 knots are expected, particularly during the afternoons. Blowing dust and temporary reductions in visibility may occur in exposed locations.

Temperature Outlook (7th to 13th July 2026)



The highest daytime temperatures are expected across the eastern and northeastern lowlands, including Sericho, Cherab, Garbatulla, and parts of Merti, where temperatures are likely to range between 35°C and 39°C.

Relatively cooler conditions are expected around Oldonyiro and the western parts influenced by the Mt. Kenya highlands, with daytime temperatures ranging between 24°C and 29°C.

Isiolo Town, Burat, Ngaremara, and Kinna are expected to experience daytime temperatures ranging between 30°C and 34°C.

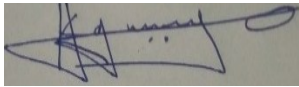
Night-time temperatures are expected to range between 14°C and 19°C in the western areas and between 20°C and 24°C across the eastern lowlands.

Advisory

- Livestock keepers are advised to continue monitoring water availability and grazing conditions as dry weather persists across most parts of the county.
- Farmers undertaking irrigated agriculture should continue using available water resources efficiently due to the prevailing dry conditions.
- Residents in areas prone to dust are encouraged to take appropriate precautions, particularly during periods of strong winds and reduced visibility.
- Motorists travelling along dry earth roads, especially in Sericho, Merti, Cherab, Garbatulla, and Kinna, should exercise caution because blowing dust may temporarily reduce visibility.
- Residents should secure temporary structures, tents, and light roofing materials against occasional strong wind gusts.
- Communities are encouraged to observe fire safety measures, as dry vegetation combined with windy conditions may increase the risk of bush and grass fires.

The public is advised to continue following official county and national weather updates for any changes in the prevailing weather conditions.
