LAIKIPIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 07 - 13 JULY, 2026

SUMMARY

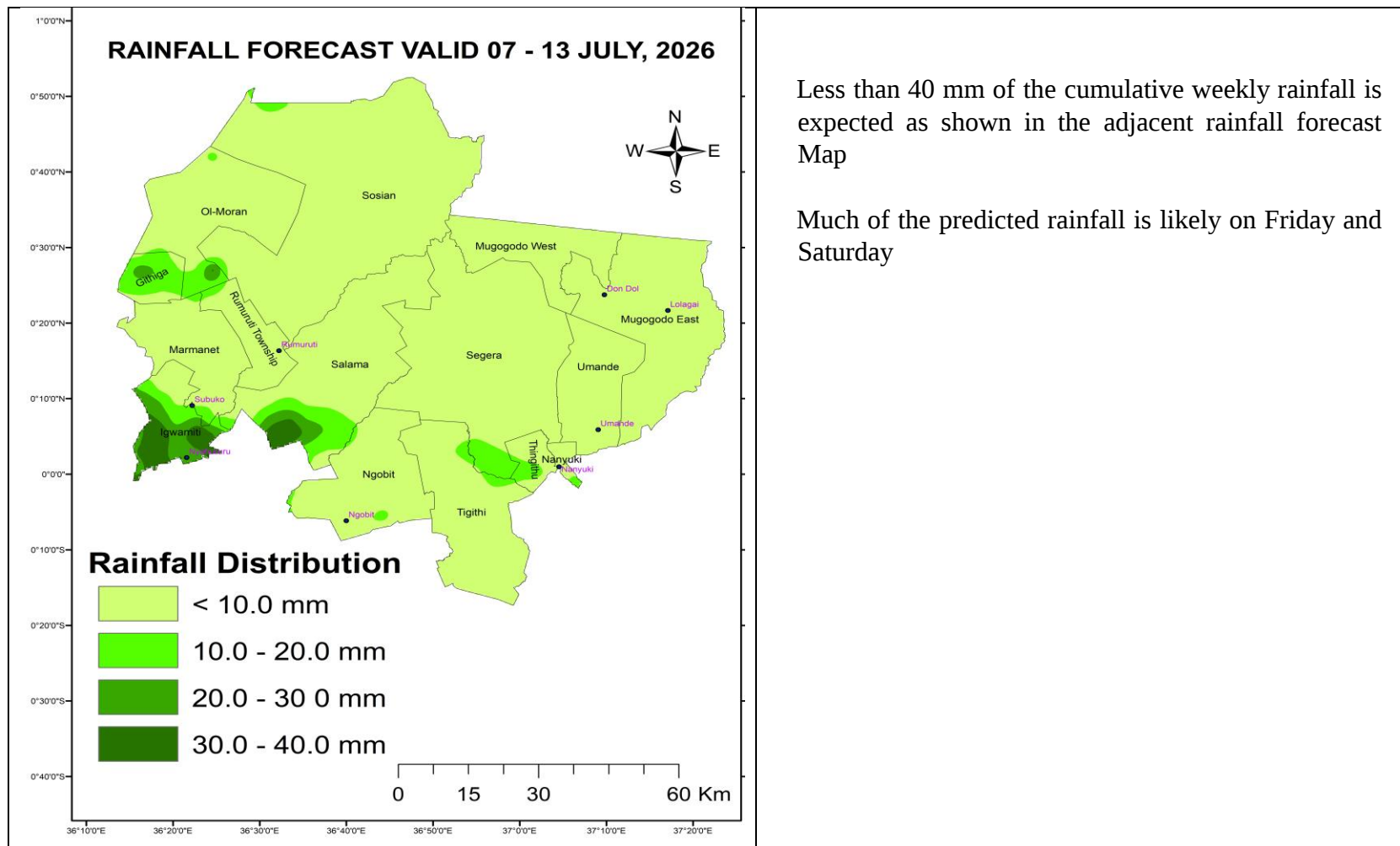
Weather Forecast for 07 – 13 July, 2026 indicates;

- Mainly sunny and dry conditions are expected over most places
- However, light to moderate rainfall is expected to continue over Few Places in Laikipia West & parts of Laikipia East
- Occasional afternoon showers and thunderstorms are likely over a few places in Nyahururu, Marmanet Forest, parts of Ngarua, Ol Pejeta, Nanyuki, Umande and a Few other places
- Strong Southerly winds with speeds > 25Knots are dominant over most places in Laikipia North and Laikipia East
- The Maximum day time temperatures are expected to rise slightly, ranging between 23°C – 29°C while the Minimum night time temperatures are likely to range 05 - 16°C
- Minimum Temperatures below 10.0°C are likely around Nyahururu, Marmanet and the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya

Weather review 30 June – 06 July, 2026

- Light to moderate amounts of rainfall were recorded in Lariak, Mutara Orchards, Thome, Ol Pejeta, Nanyuki, 3 Rivers and a few other areas
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased over most places*
- The day time maximum temperatures increased over most places while the night time minimum temperatures varied from place to place

RAINFALL CATEGORIES		RAINFALL COVERAGE	
< 5 mm	Light	TERMs	MEANING
5 – 20 mm	Moderate	Most places	Between 67% and 100%
20 – 50 mm	Heavy	Several Places	Between 33% and 67%
> 50 mm	Very heavy	Few places	Below 33%
