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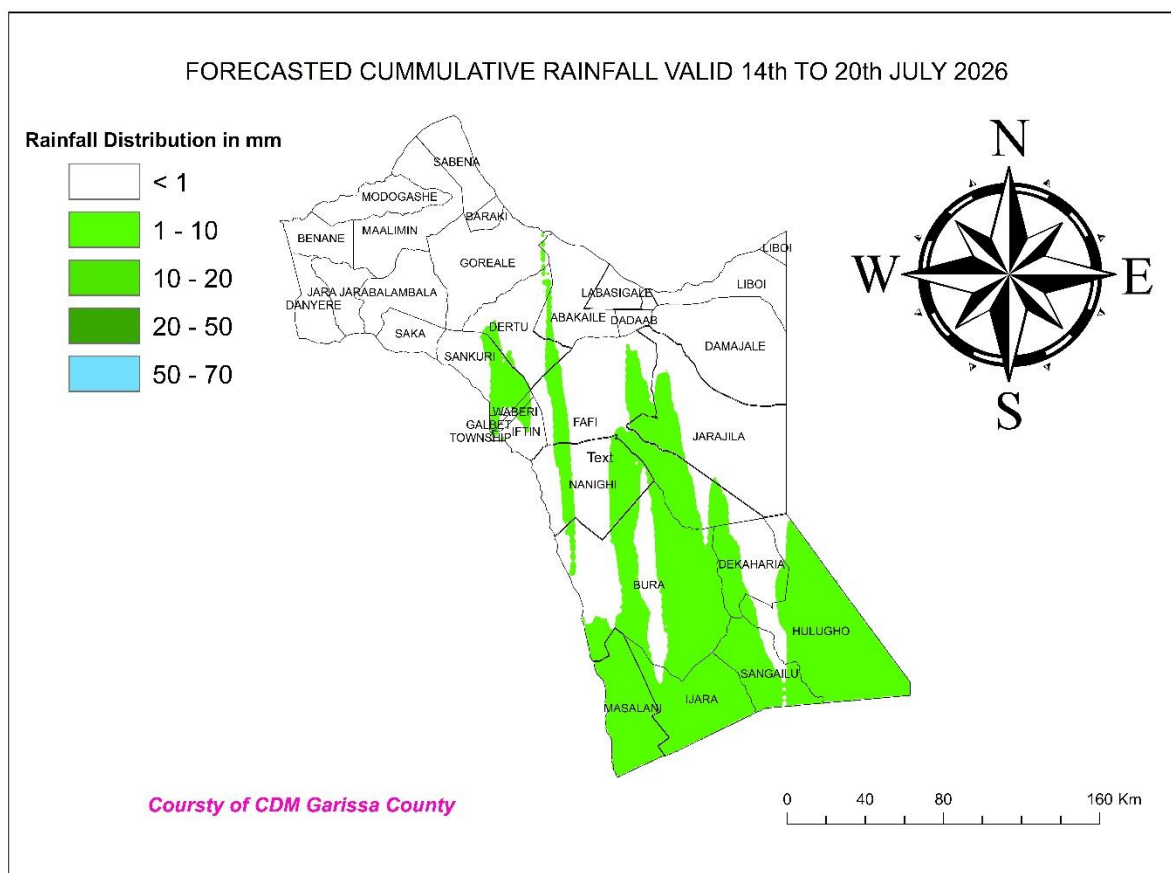


Figure 1: Expected Rainfall distribution over Garissa County valid Tuesday 14th to Monday 20th July 2026

- ❖ Weak southerly winds exceeding 10 knots (6m/s) expected.

APPENDIX 1: KEY OF SCIENTIFIC WORDS USED

Most Places:	Between 66% and 100%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.
Several Places:	Between 33% and 66%	Rain in multiple but not most parts of the region.
Few Places:	Between 0 and 33%	Rain in a small portion of the region.
Above Normal:	More than 125% of LTM	
Near Normal:	75% - 125% of LTM	
Below Normal:	Below 75% of LTM
