WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Period of forecast: Tuesday 14th July 2026 to Monday 20th July 2026

REF: KMD/BGM/WK/FCST/28 -2026

Date of issue: Monday 13th July 2026

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that:

- In the morning, most places are likely to experience sunny intervals.
- In the afternoon several places are also likely to receive sunny intervals. However, few places may receive light rain.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 24 and 28 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 17 degrees Celsius.

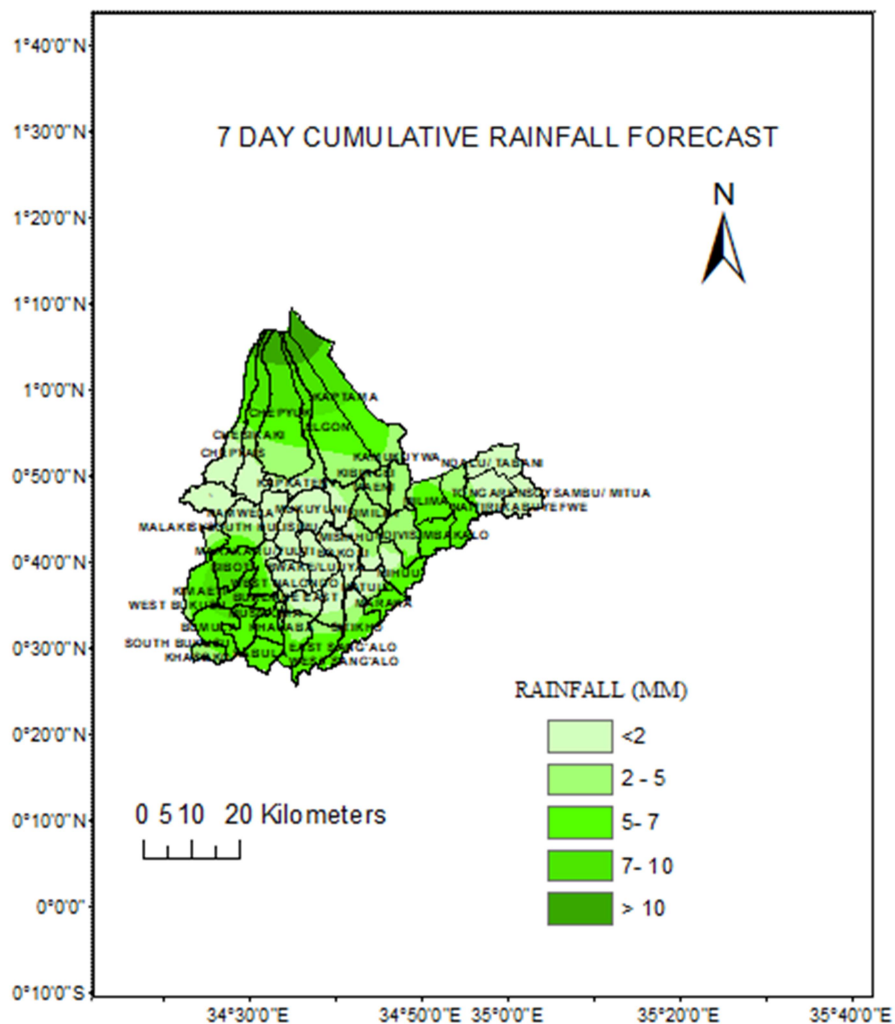


Figure 1: Expected Rainfall Distribution from 14th July 2026 to 20th July 2026

The expected rainfall distribution for the next seven days from Tuesday 14th July 2026 to Monday 20th July 2026 is shown in Figure 1.

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Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  and rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Key to hazard colours:

Explanation of terminologies

Terminology	Meaning
Light rainfall	< 5 mm
Moderate rainfall	5 – 20 mm
Heavy rainfall	20 -50 mm
Very heavy rainfall	>50 mm
Few places	Below 33% coverage
Several places	Between 33% and 67% coverage
Most places	Between 67% and 100% coverage

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Practice water conservation and efficient water use measures.
- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to reduce the risk of being struck by lightning.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
