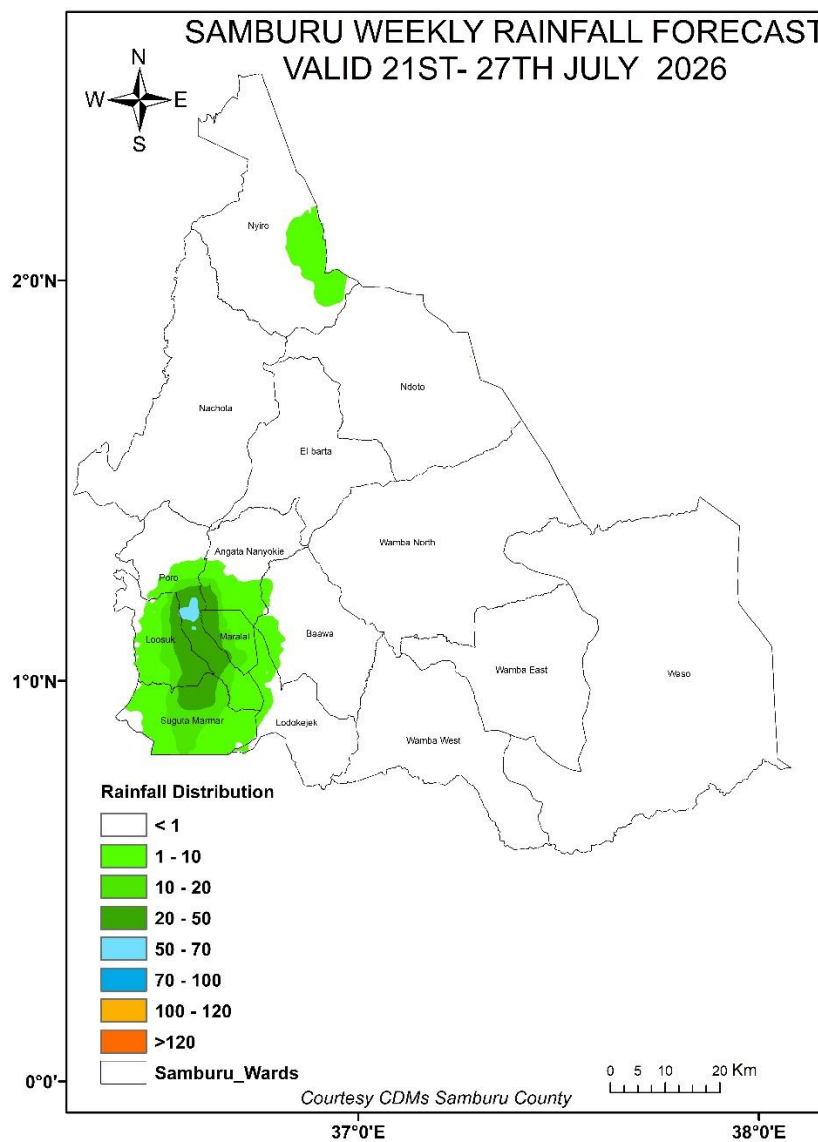

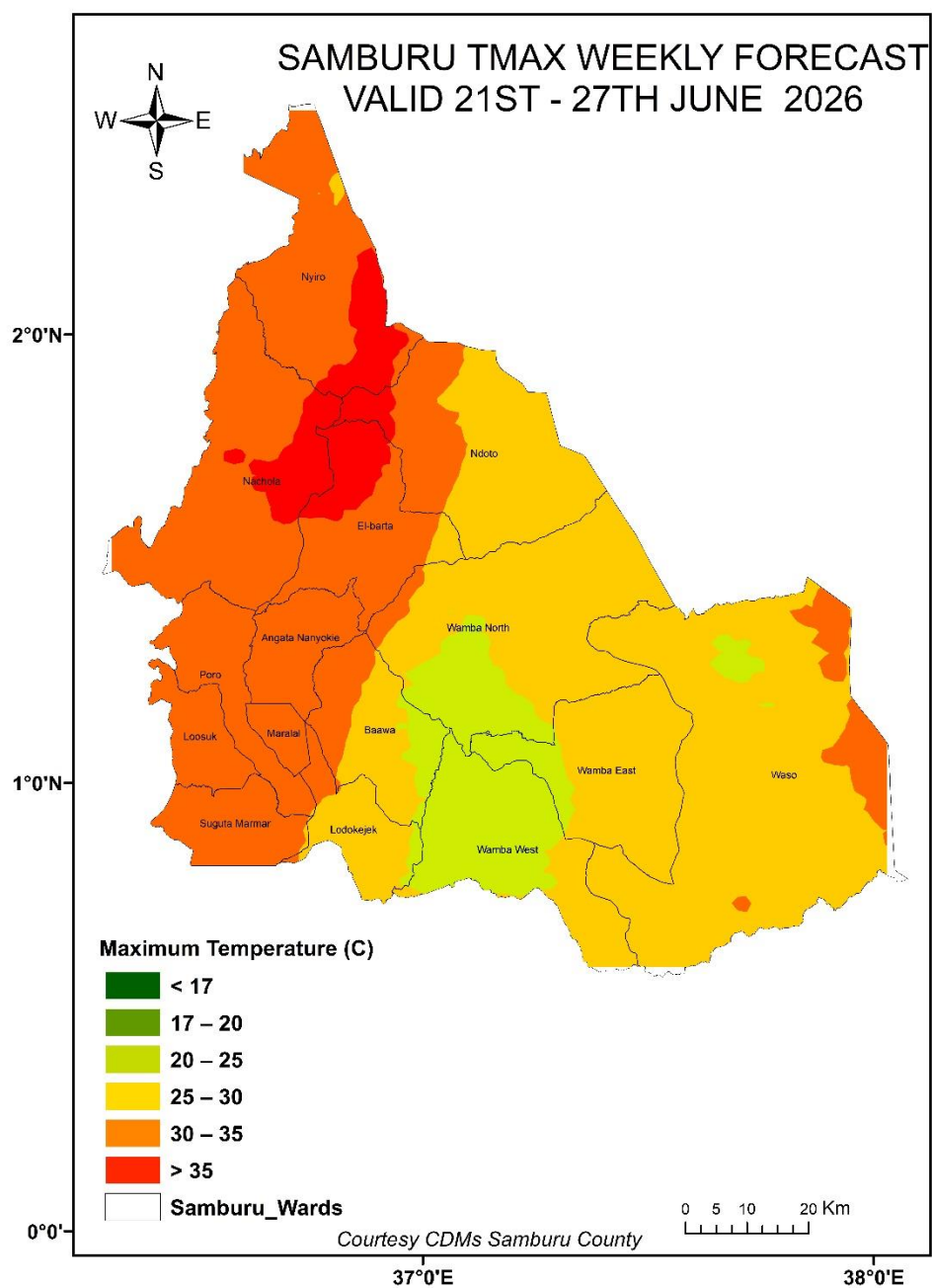

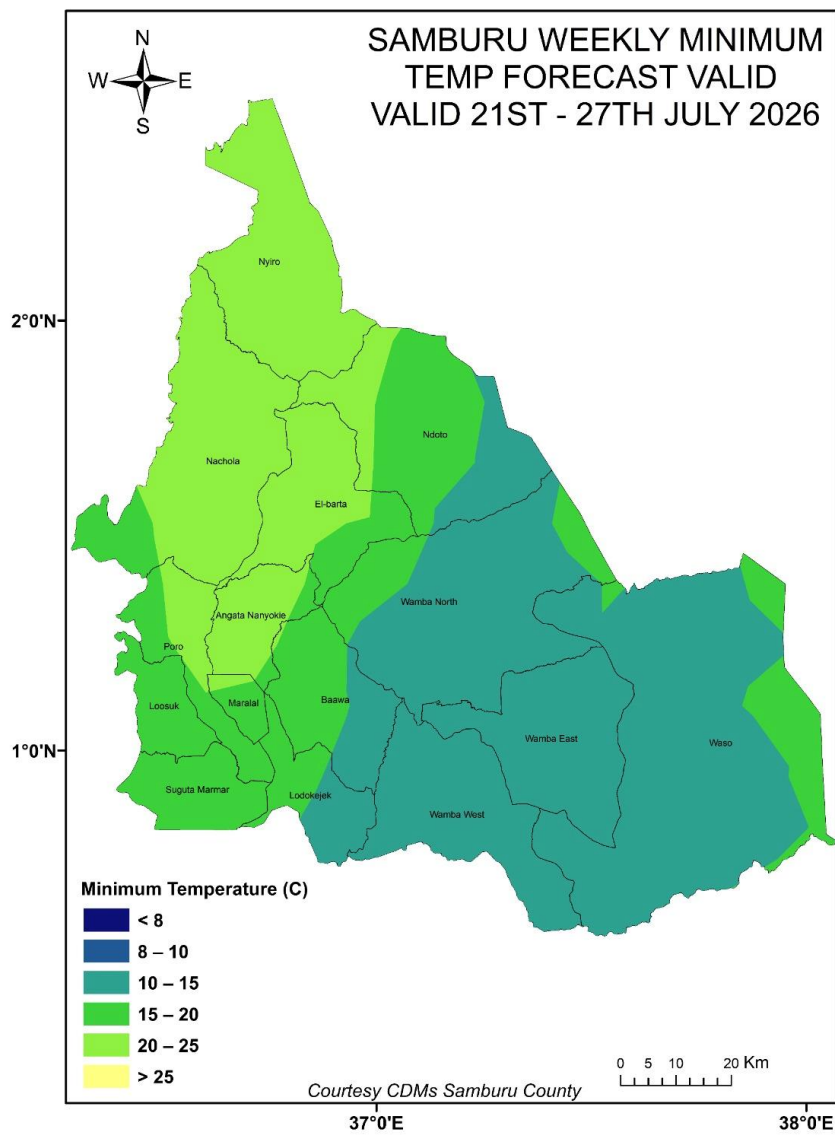


SAMBURU COUNTY WEEKLY MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FORECAST

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- ❖ The above Figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 21st July to 27th July, 2026. Mainly sunny intervals are expected during the day with partly cloudy nights in the forecast period.
- ❖ Rains are likely in Maralal ,Sunguta Marmar and parts of Loosuk,Poro Angata Nanyokie as shown in Figure 1.
- ❖ Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period. Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 25.0 °C and 35.0 °C as shown in Figure 2.
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 10.0 °C and 20.0 °C as shown in Figure 3.
- ❖ The weather outlook for the week of 28th July to 3rd August 2026, Samburu County is likely to experience Dry weather conditions over several places with few wet areas in central.
