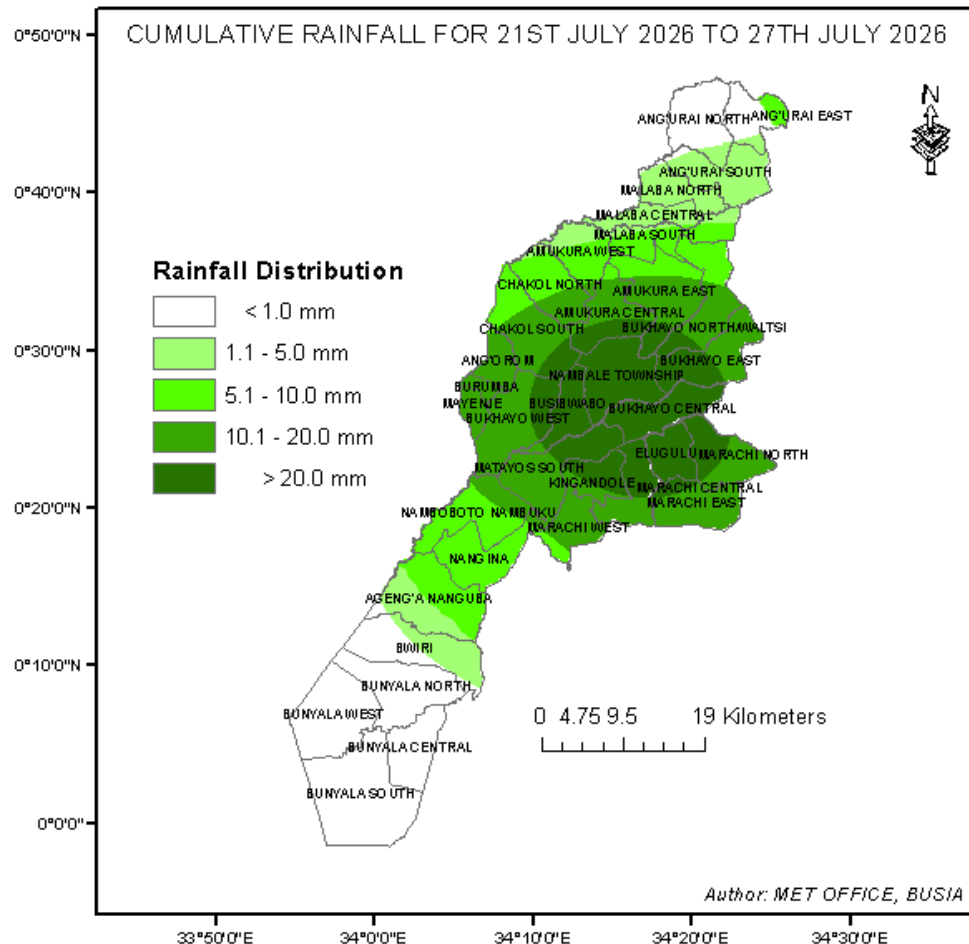

Period of forecast: Tuesday 21st July 2026 to Monday 27th July 2026

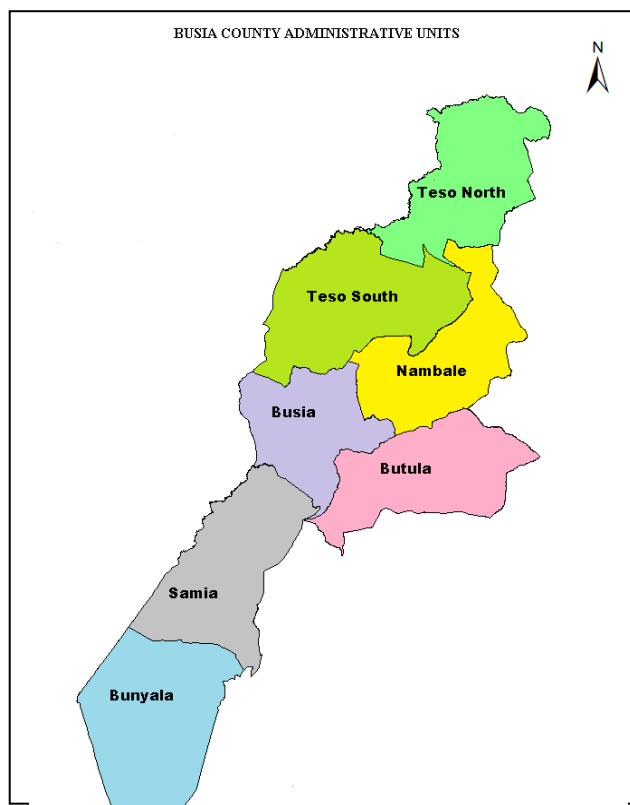
Date of issue: Monday 20th July 2026

Summary

Mornings this week will be mainly dry save for a possibility of rain on Monday morning over Central Busia. Central areas of Busia County are likely to receive moderate rainfall accompanied by thunderstorms on most afternoons during the coming week. But the showers will be scattered. Some places may not get rain every day.

The far south of Busia County and the extreme north will experience much lighter rainfall. The best chance of a downpour in these areas will be on Thursday night and Friday afternoon.

Daytime temperatures will remain uncomfortably high throughout the week, peaking at 30 or 31 degrees Celsius in central parts of Busia County on Wednesday and Thursday.



Forecast zones in Busia County for the week ahead

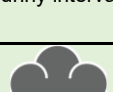
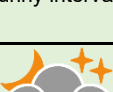
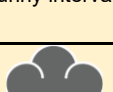
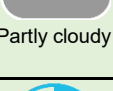
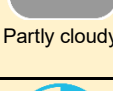
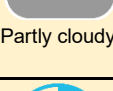
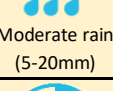
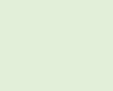
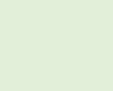
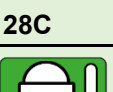
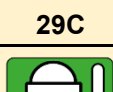
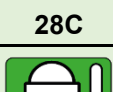
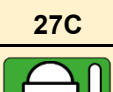
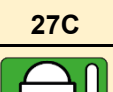
Zone 1: Teso South, Nambale, Butula and Busia Sub Counties (slightly high chance of rain)

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- Harvest rainwater and store it safely for future use in case it rains.
- If you hear thunder or see lightning, find shelter inside a building. Stay away from windows and doors.
- Protect your animals from cold rain and the risk of lightning strikes, strong wind or hail by bringing them into their shed when it rains.
- Mulch your farms to retain moisture among growing plants.
- Seek further guidance from agriculture extension officers in your ward on farm activities.

Note: There may be differences in amount of rainfall forecasted and amount of rainfall received.
