**Along the Western Indian Ocean Region**  
**Validity: 25/07/2026 - 31/07/2026**

**1.0 GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**1.1 Wind Speed & Direction:**

Southerly to South-Westerly winds are expected over Somalia waters with wind speeds of 14 to 28 knots (07-14m/s) throughout the forecast period.

East-South-Easterly to Southerly winds are expected over Kenya and Tanzania waters with wind speeds of 04 to 20 knots (02-10. m/s) throughout the forecast period.

**1.2 Sig. Wave Height and Direction:**

East-south easterly waves are expected over Somalia, Kenya and Tanzania waters with wave heights of 1.5-2.5m ( $\approx$  0.6–7.5 ft) throughout the forecast period.

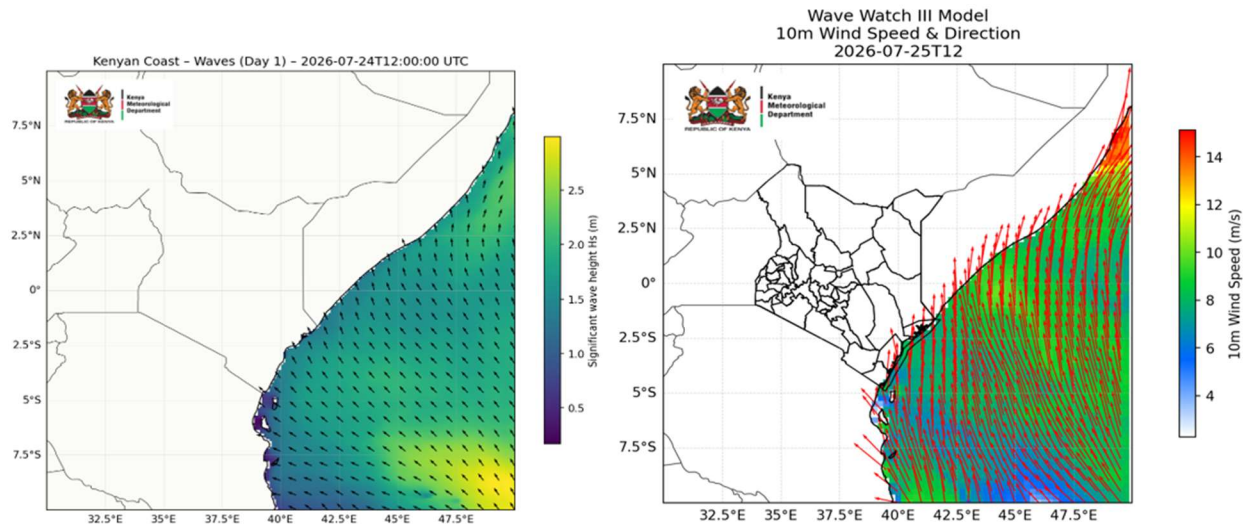
**1.3 Sea condition**

- Gentle breeze to strong breeze with wind speeds of 07–14m/s (14 to 28 Knots) expected over Somalia waters throughout the forecast period.
- Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze with wind speeds of 04-10m/s (08 to 20 Knots) expected over Kenya, and Tanzania waters throughout the forecast period.
- Slight to moderate sea condition with wave heights of 0.5–2.5m ( $\approx$  1.5–7.5 ft) expected over the Somalia, Kenya and Tanzania waters throughout the forecast period.

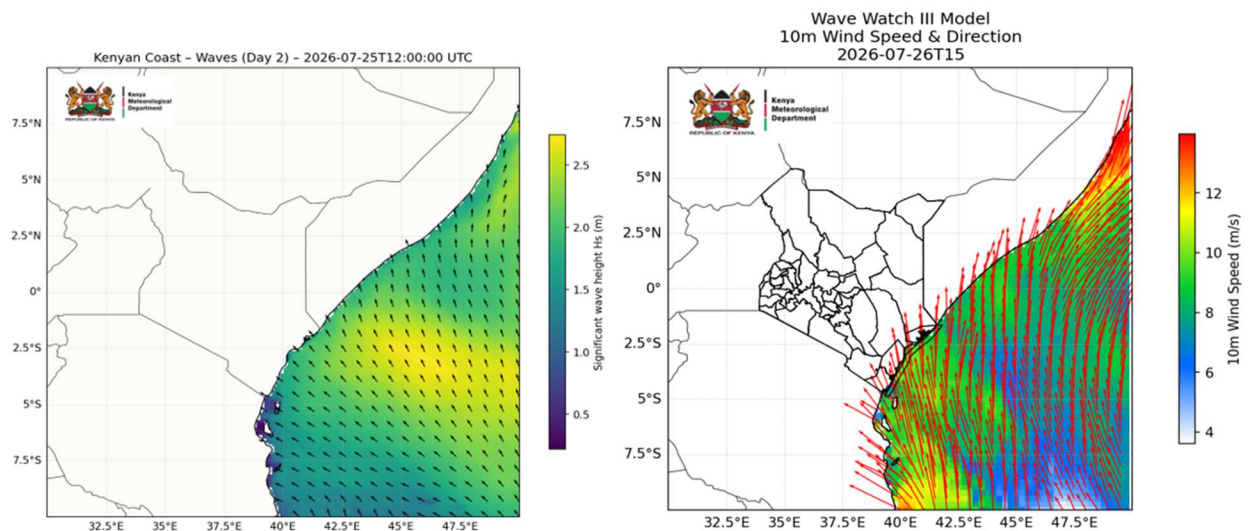

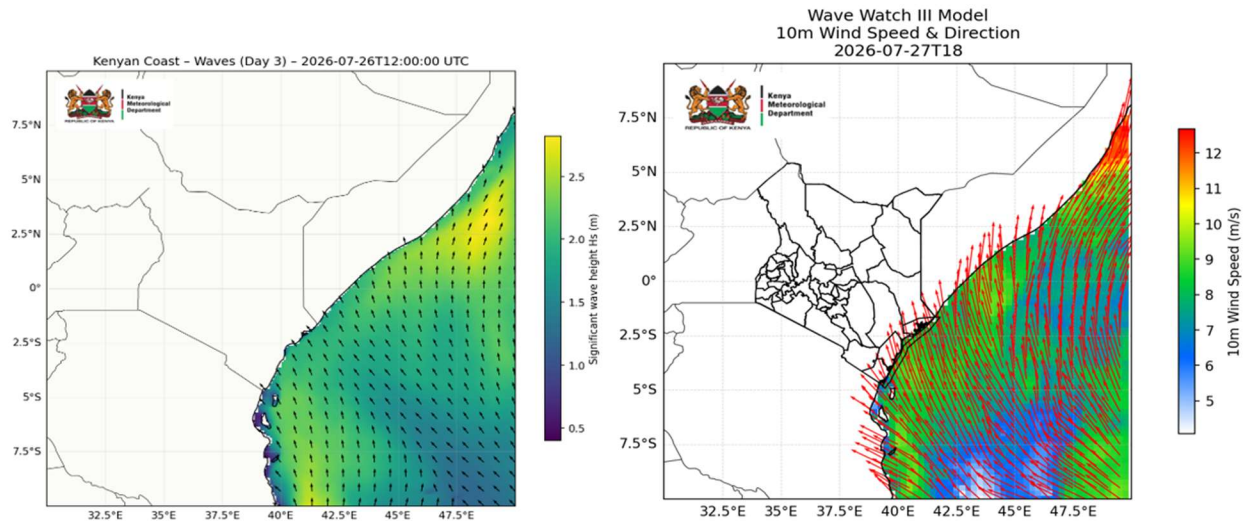

Wave height: 0.5 m to 2.5m ( $\approx$  1.5– 7.5ft)

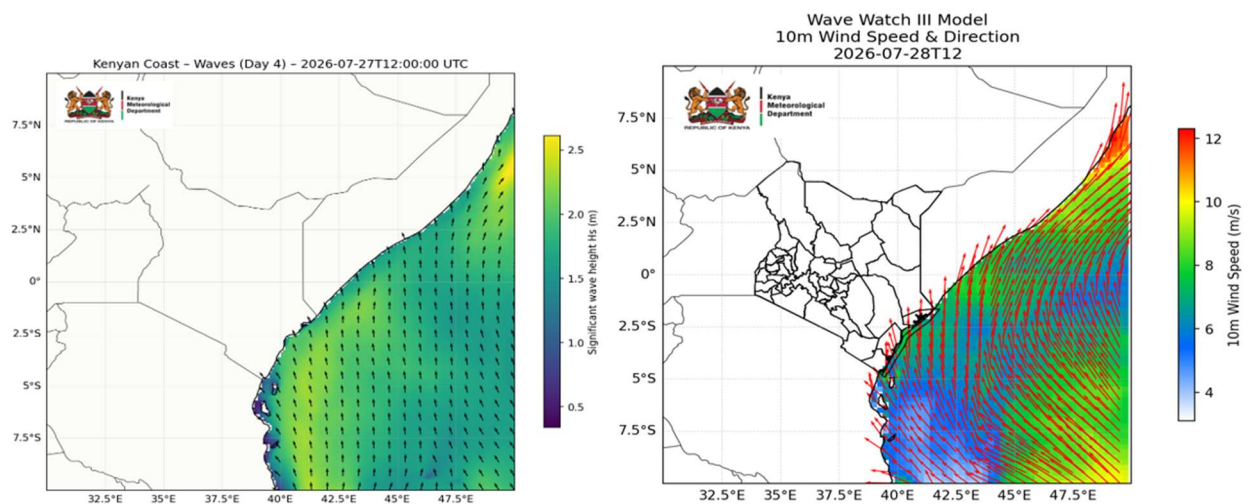
10m Winds: 10-24 knots ( $\approx$  05– 12m/s)

Wave height: 0.5 m to 2.5 m ( $\approx$  1.5– 7.5ft)

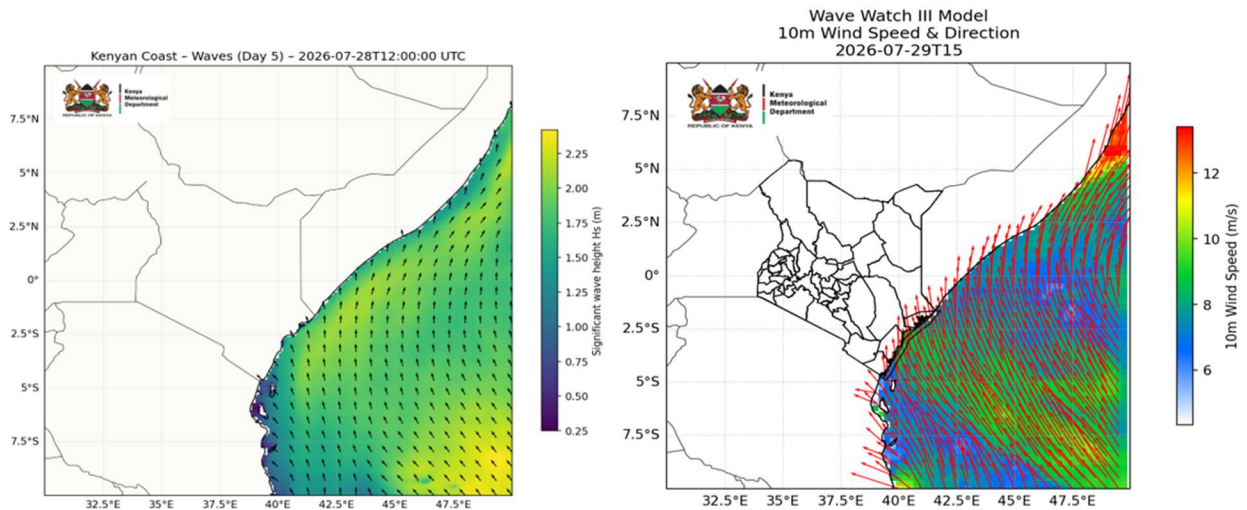
10m Winds: 08-24 knots ( $\approx$  04 – 12m/s)

Wave height: 0.2 m to 2.5m ( $\approx 0.6$ –7.5ft)

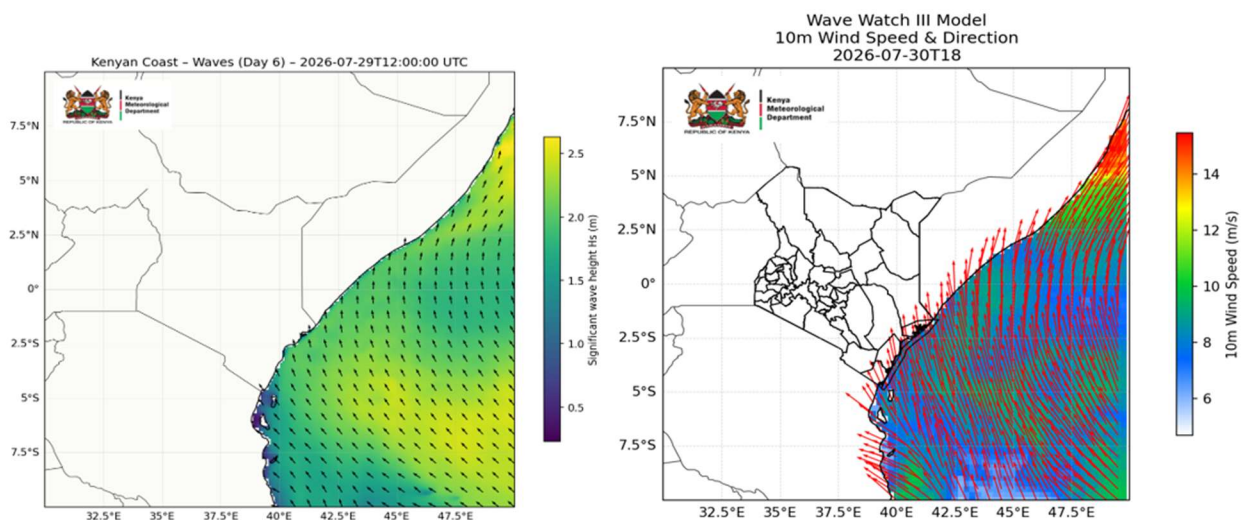
10m Winds: 12-26 knots ( $\approx 06$ –13m/s)

10m Winds: 12-28knots ( $\approx 06$ –14m/s)

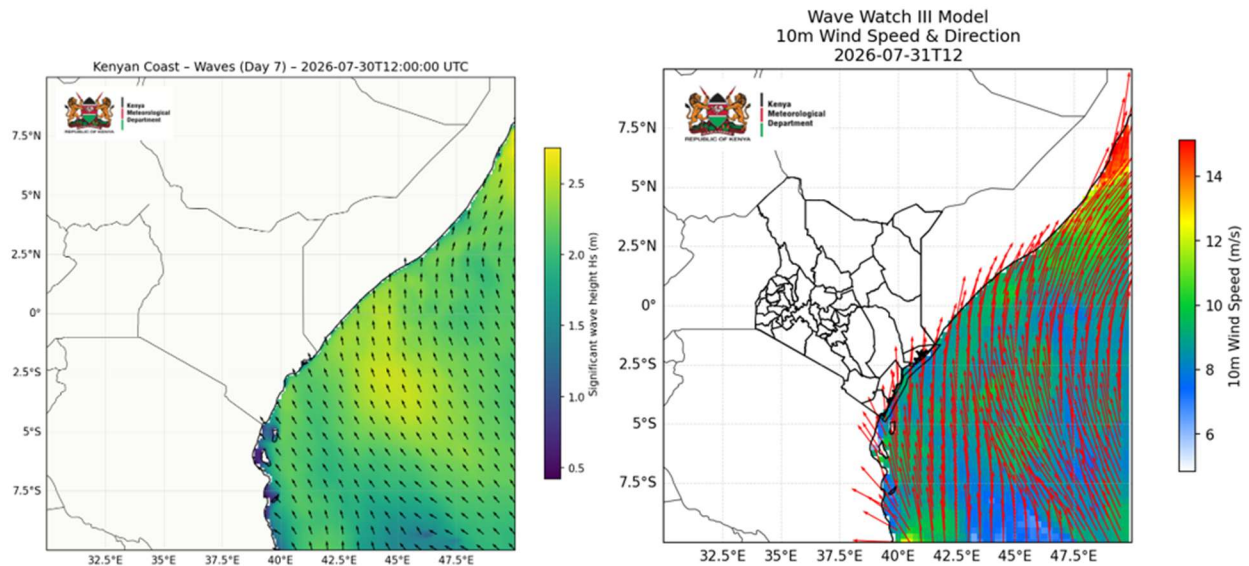

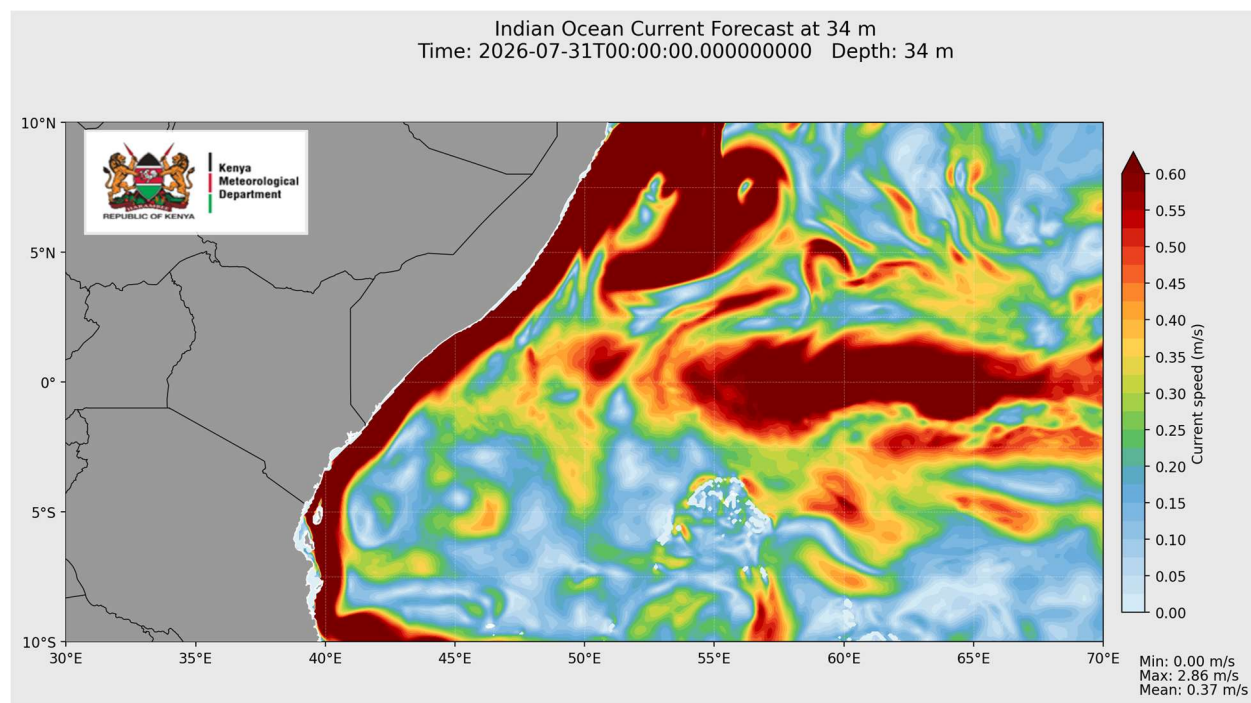
