LAIKIPIA COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 04 - 10 AUGUST, 2026

SUMMARY

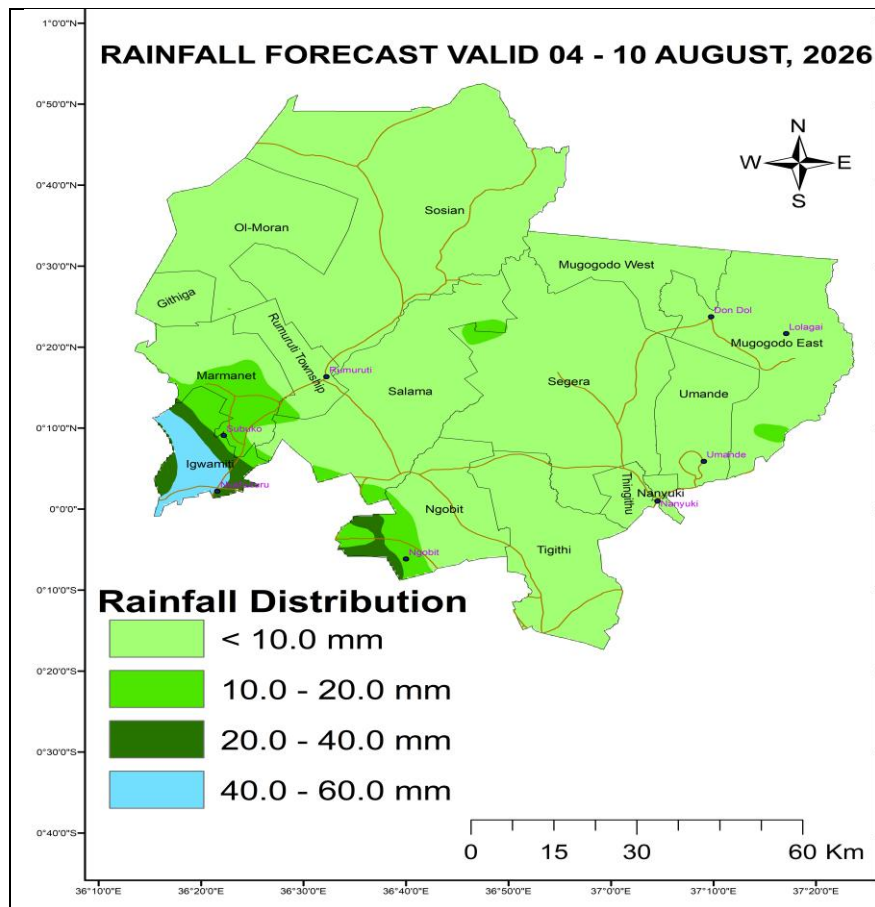
Weather Forecast for 04 – 10 August, 2026 indicates;

- Cloudy/Sunny conditions expected over Most places
- However, light rains are likely in the morning followed by isolated showers and thunderstorms over Few Places in the afternoon over Igwamiti, Marmanet, Githiga, Ndaragwa in Laikipia West and a few places over Nanyuki, Umande and Sirimon in Laikipia East.
- Strong Southerly winds with speeds > 25Knots remains dominant over most places in Laikipia North and parts of Laikipia East
- The Maximum day time temperatures are expected to fall slightly ranging between 22°C – 27°C while the Minimum night time temperatures are likely to range 05 - 15°C
- Minimum Temperatures below 10.0°C are likely around Nyahururu, Marmanet and the regions adjacent to Mt Kenya

Weather review 28 July – 03 August, 2026

- Light to moderate amounts of rainfall were recorded in Kinamba, Lariak, Sipili, Mutara Orchards, Ol Pejeta, 3 Rivers Mugie, Ol Jogi and a few other areas
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts increased over few places*
- The day time maximum temperatures decreased over most places while the night time minimum temperatures varied from place to place

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days (04 - 10 August, 2026)



Less than 60 mm of the cumulative weekly rainfall is expected as shown in the adjacent rainfall forecast Map

The predicted rainfall is likely on Tuesday and Friday to Sunday with light intermittent showers the rest of the week.
