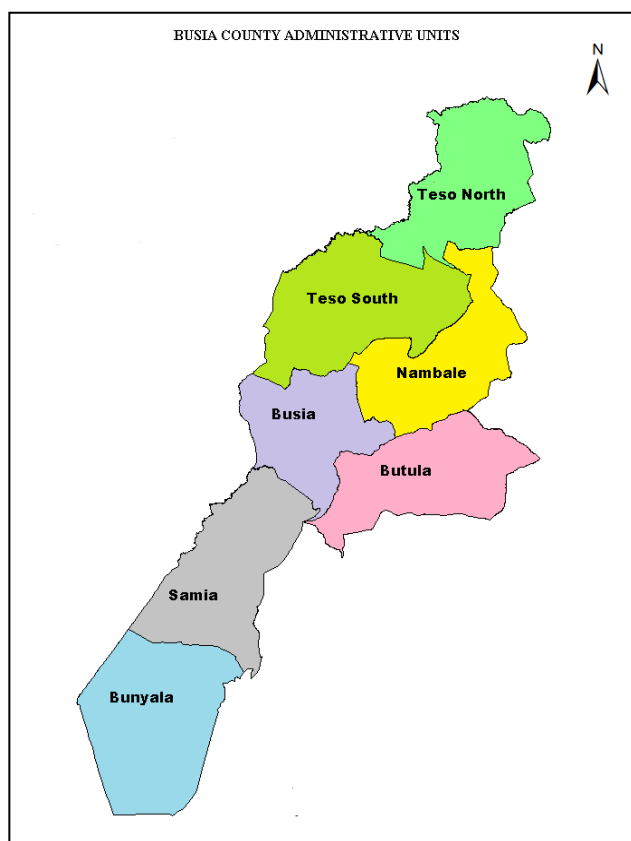




Forecast zones in Busia County for the week ahead

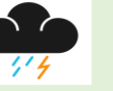
Zone 1: Teso North, Teso South, Nambale, Butula and Busia Sub Counties (slightly high chance of rain)

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- Protect your animals from cold rain and the risk of lightning strikes, strong wind or hail by bringing them into their shed when it rains.
- Seek further guidance from agriculture extension officers in your ward on farm activities.
