General Outlook/Summary.

Light to moderate rainfall is expected in the county during the forecast period (Table 1 below). Temperature range is likely to be between 12-27°C.

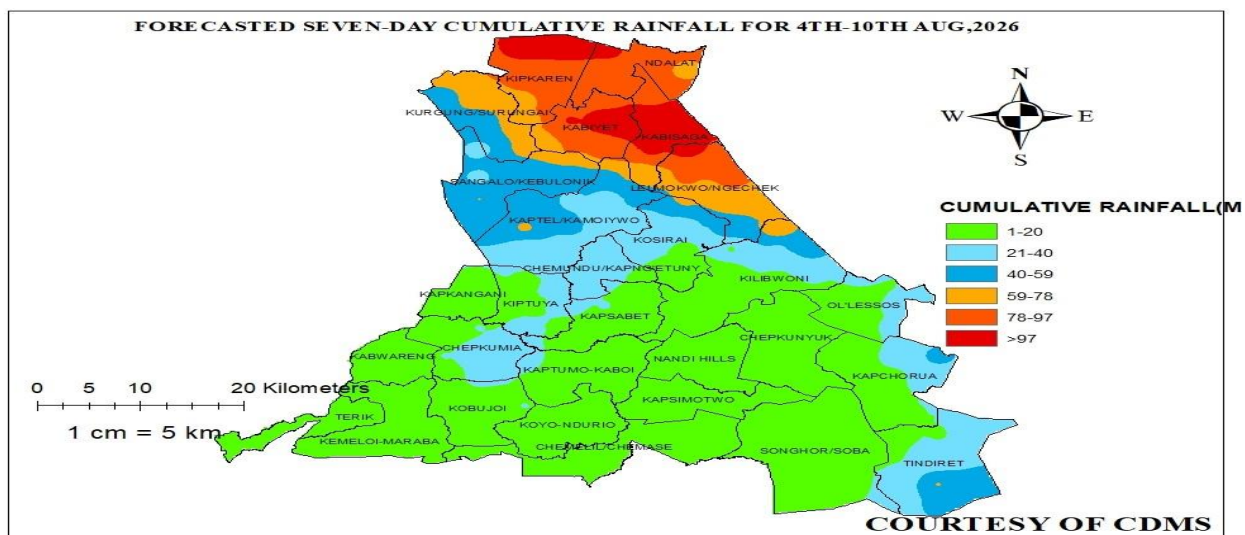


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 4TH -10TH Aug 2026

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Sunny intervals expected during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions:** Light rains confined to few places is likely to be experienced on Friday whereas moderate rainfall covering few places is likely on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Monday. Moderate rainfall accompanied with lightning and thunderstorm is expected over many places on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- **Maximum temperature** ranges likely to be 25-27°C whereas **minimum temperatures** range likely to be 12°- 15°C during the forecast period

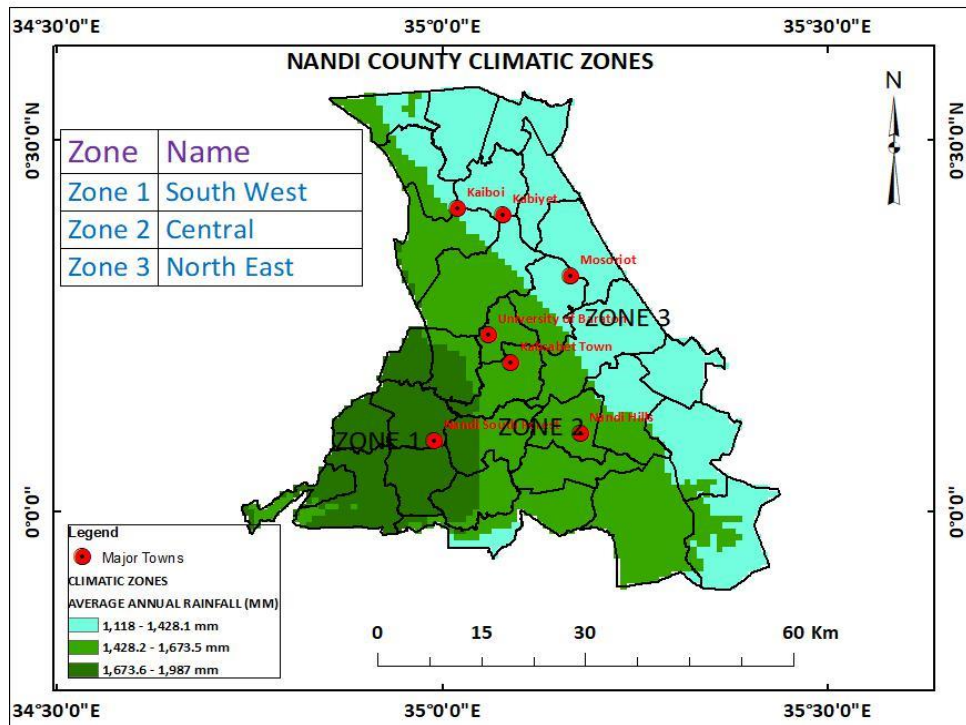


Figure 2: Nandi climatic zones

APPENDIX I: INTERPRETATION OF TERM

S/No	Term	Rainfall Amount (24 hrs)	Description
1	Light	< 5mm	Gentle rain, drizzle.
2	Moderate/Lingering	5 - 20 mm	Steady, noticeable rain.
3	Heavy	21 - 50 mm	Intense rain, possible thunder.
4	Very heavy	> 50 mm	Prolonged rain, high intensity.

S/No	Term	Area Affected	Description
1	Few places	< 33%	Rain in a small portion of the region.
2	Several places	33% - 66%	Rain in multiple but not in most parts of the region.
3	Most places	> 66%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.

S/No	Term	Probability of Occurrence	Description
1	Possible	10% - 30%	There is low confidence.
2	Chance of/May	31% - 50%	There is moderate confidence.
3	Likely	51% - 75%	There event is more probable than not.
4	Expected	76% - 90%	There is high confidence.
5	Very likely	91% - 99%	There is very high confidence. Almost certain.
6	Certain	100%	The event is guaranteed to occur.
