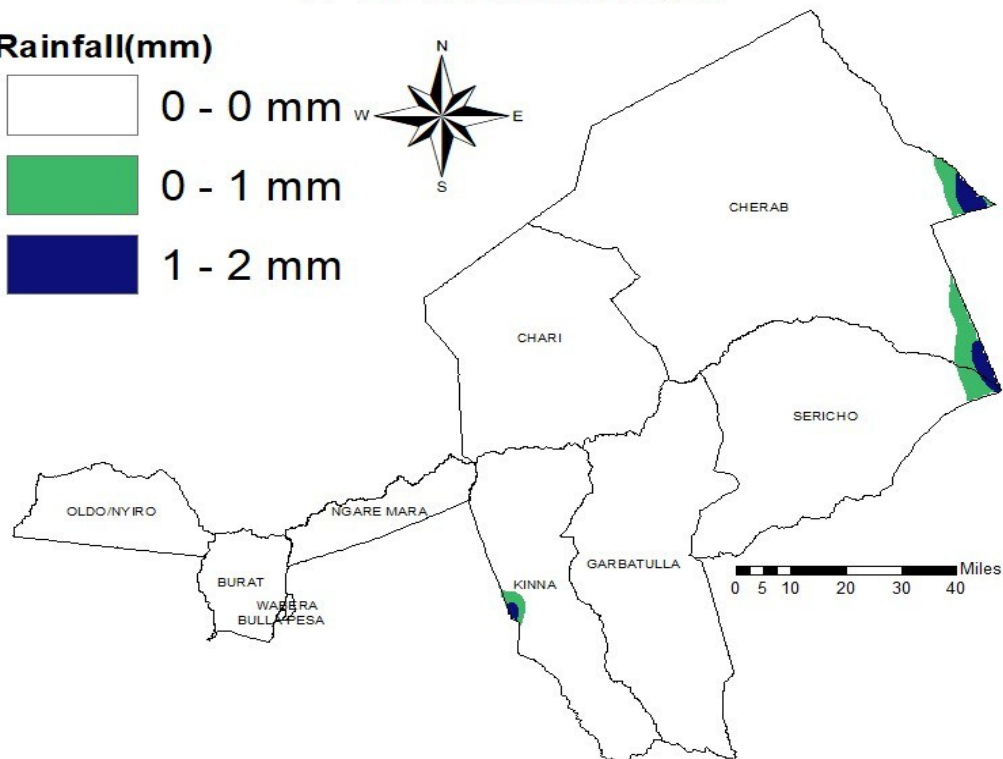
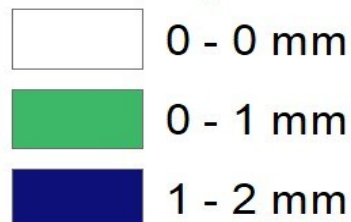
ISIOLO COUNTY WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST

Isiolo County Weather Outlook (11th to 17th August 2026)

Most parts of Isiolo County are expected to remain generally dry during the forecast period 11th to 17th August 2026 as the cool and dry season continues to influence weather conditions across

northern Kenya. No significant rainfall is expected over most parts of the county, although isolated light showers of less than 5 mm may be experienced in a few western highland-influenced areas. Cool mornings and nights are likely over the western parts of the county, particularly around Oldonyiro and areas bordering Laikipia County, while warm to hot daytime conditions will persist across the central, eastern, and northeastern areas.

Moderate to occasionally strong winds are expected across the county, with localized dusty conditions likely over open rangelands, dry riverbeds, and exposed areas.

1. Isiolo Central Sub-County (Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, Bulapesa, Oldonyiro)

Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, Bulapesa, and surrounding areas are expected to experience predominantly sunny to partly cloudy conditions throughout the forecast period. Oldonyiro and neighbouring western areas may occasionally experience increased cloud cover, with a slight chance of isolated light showers of less than 5 mm, though most locations are expected to remain dry.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of approximately 12–25 knots are expected across most areas.

Occasional gusty winds may develop during afternoon hours, particularly over open plains and along major transport corridors.

2. Garbatulla Sub-County (Garbatulla, Kinna, Sericho)

Garbatulla, Kinna, and surrounding settlements are expected to remain largely dry with sunny to partly cloudy conditions. The continued dry weather may sustain pressure on pasture, browse, and surface water resources in some areas.

Wind Forecast

Moderate to strong winds ranging between 15–30 knots are expected.

Dusty conditions may occur during the afternoons, especially over open rangelands and bare soils.

3. Merti Sub-County (Merti, Bulesa, Kom)

Dry and mostly sunny weather is expected across Merti, Bulesa, Kom, and neighboring areas throughout the forecast period. No significant rainfall is anticipated.

Wind Forecast

Moderate to strong winds of approximately 15–30 knots are expected.

Localized dust lifting is likely over exposed dry surfaces.

4. Ngaremara Areas

Ngaremara and neighbouring locations are expected to remain generally dry. Occasional afternoon cloud development may occur, but rainfall is unlikely.

Wind Forecast

Moderate winds of around 15–25 knots are expected.

Occasional stronger gusts may occur in open areas.

5. Sericho and Cherab Areas

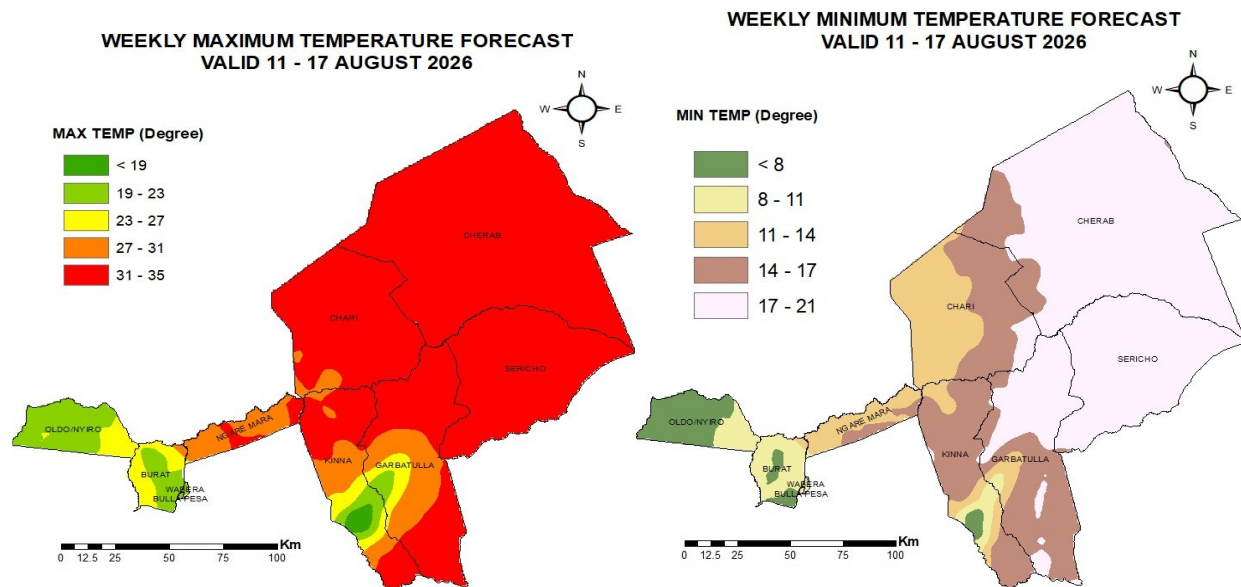
Sericho, Cherab, and the eastern parts of the county are expected to remain hot, sunny, and dry throughout the forecast period. No significant rainfall is expected.

Wind Forecast

Strong winds of approximately 20–32 knots are expected, particularly during afternoon hours. Blowing dust and temporary reductions in visibility may occur in exposed locations.

Temperature Outlook (11th to 17th August 2026)

Isiolo County is expected to continue experiencing generally warm to hot daytime temperatures, with cooler conditions over the western highland-influenced areas around Oldonyiro.



Western Highland Areas

Oldonyiro and areas bordering Laikipia County

Daytime temperatures : 24°C – 29°C

Night-time temperatures: 12°C – 18°C

Central Areas

Isiolo Town, Burat, Wabera, Bulapesa and Ngaremara

Daytime temperatures : 30°C – 34°C

Night-time temperatures: 18°C – 22°C

Southern and Eastern Areas

Kinna, Garbatulla, Merti, Bulesa and Kom

Daytime temperatures : 32°C – 37°C

Night-time temperatures: 20°C – 24°C

Northeastern Lowlands

Sericho, Cherab and surrounding areas

Daytime temperatures: 35°C – 39°C

Night-time temperatures: 22°C – 25°C

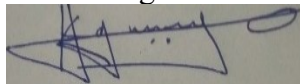
Advisory

- Livestock keepers are advised to continue monitoring water availability and grazing conditions as dry weather persists across most parts of the county.

- Residents in areas prone to dust are encouraged to take appropriate precautions, particularly during periods of strong winds and reduced visibility.
- Motorists travelling along dry earth roads, especially in Sericho, Merti, Cherab, Garbatulla, and Kinna, should exercise caution as blowing dust may temporarily reduce visibility.
- Communities are encouraged to observe fire safety measures, as dry vegetation combined with windy conditions may increase the risk of bush and grass fires.
- Livestock owners should continue planning livestock movements carefully and avoid over-concentration around limited water sources to reduce pressure on available pasture and water resources.
- Farmers and pastoralists are encouraged to utilize available weather and climate advisories for informed decision-making regarding crop and livestock management.
- Residents are advised to dress warmly during early mornings and nights, particularly in Oldonyiro and other western highland-influenced areas where temperatures are expected to remain relatively cool.

The public is advised to continue following official county and national weather updates for any changes in the prevailing weather conditions.
