

**DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST**

**Issued at: 1500 EAT on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2025**

**Valid: 0000 EAT on 9<sup>th</sup> March 2025 to 0000 EAT on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025**



**GENERAL OUTLOOK**

**Morning sea state:**

- Light and variable winds (02-06 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 2 feet (0.6m) with small period waves of (8-10 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Afternoon sea state:**

- Light E to SE winds (10-14 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 2-3 feet (0.6m-0.9m) with small period waves of (8-9 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

**Visibility:**

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

### **i. KWALE**

- Morning Winds: NNE 2 to 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ENE 2 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ENE 2 feet at 8 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small short period waves.
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)

- Low Tide: **07:37AM; 1.3m, 07:29 PM;1.5m**

### **ii. MOMBASA**

- Morning Winds: N 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light N winds with a slight chop. Very small mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 10 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:17PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **00:11 AM; 2.6m, 01:43 PM; 2.1m,**
- Low Tide: **07:35AM; 1.3m, 07:19PM; 1.5m**

### **iii. KILIFI**

- Morning Winds: N 5 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 10 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **5:57AM** and sunset; **6:15PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **00:11AM; 2.3m, 01:48PM; 1.9m,**
- Low Tide; **07:36AM; 1.1m, 07:22PM;1.2m**

### **iv. LAMU**

- Morning Winds: NNW 3 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 2 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Very small short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: E 10 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 3 feet at 9 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy E winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; **00.38AM** and sunset; **6:10PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **00.08 AM; 2.2m, 01.50 PM; 1.8m,**
- Low Tide: **07:37 AM; 1.0m, 07:19 PM; 1.2m**

**Advisory**

- Relatively calm conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.6m-0.9m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Calm breeze to Fresh breeze of (02-14 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
