

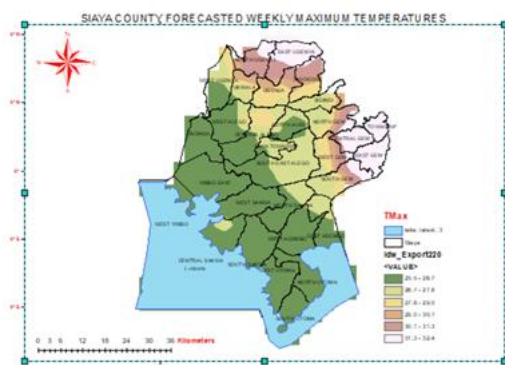


Figure 3a: Forecasted weekly Maximum temperatures

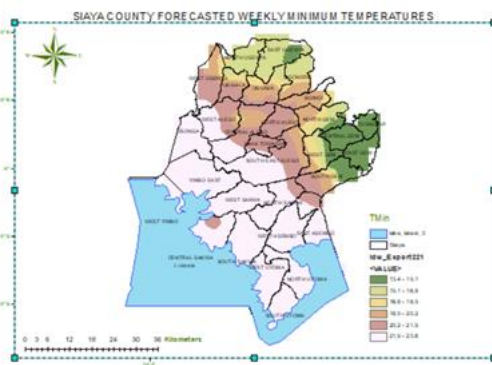


Figure 3b: Forecasted weekly Minimum Temperatures

Figure 2 shows the map for forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall. The rainfall is expected to range from 0.0mm to 2.3mm. Most parts of the county are likely to receive between 0.0mm and 0.4mm of rainfall during the forecast period. Some parts of w. Ugenya and North Ugenya are likely to experience between 1.2mm and 2.3 mm cumulatively during the forecast period. Figure 3a and 3b shows forecasted weekly maximum and minimum temperatures ranging between 25.5°C and 32.4°C and 13.4°C and 23.6°C respectively

Period of forecast: Tuesday 25th August 2026 to Monday 31st August 2026

Date of issue: Monday 24th August 2026

Summary of The Forecast

Regions; 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5, morning sunny/sunny interval conditions likely throughout the forecast period, afternoon/night shower associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Tuesday.. Temperatures of between 31°C and 29°C during the day and between 20°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate to Strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period
