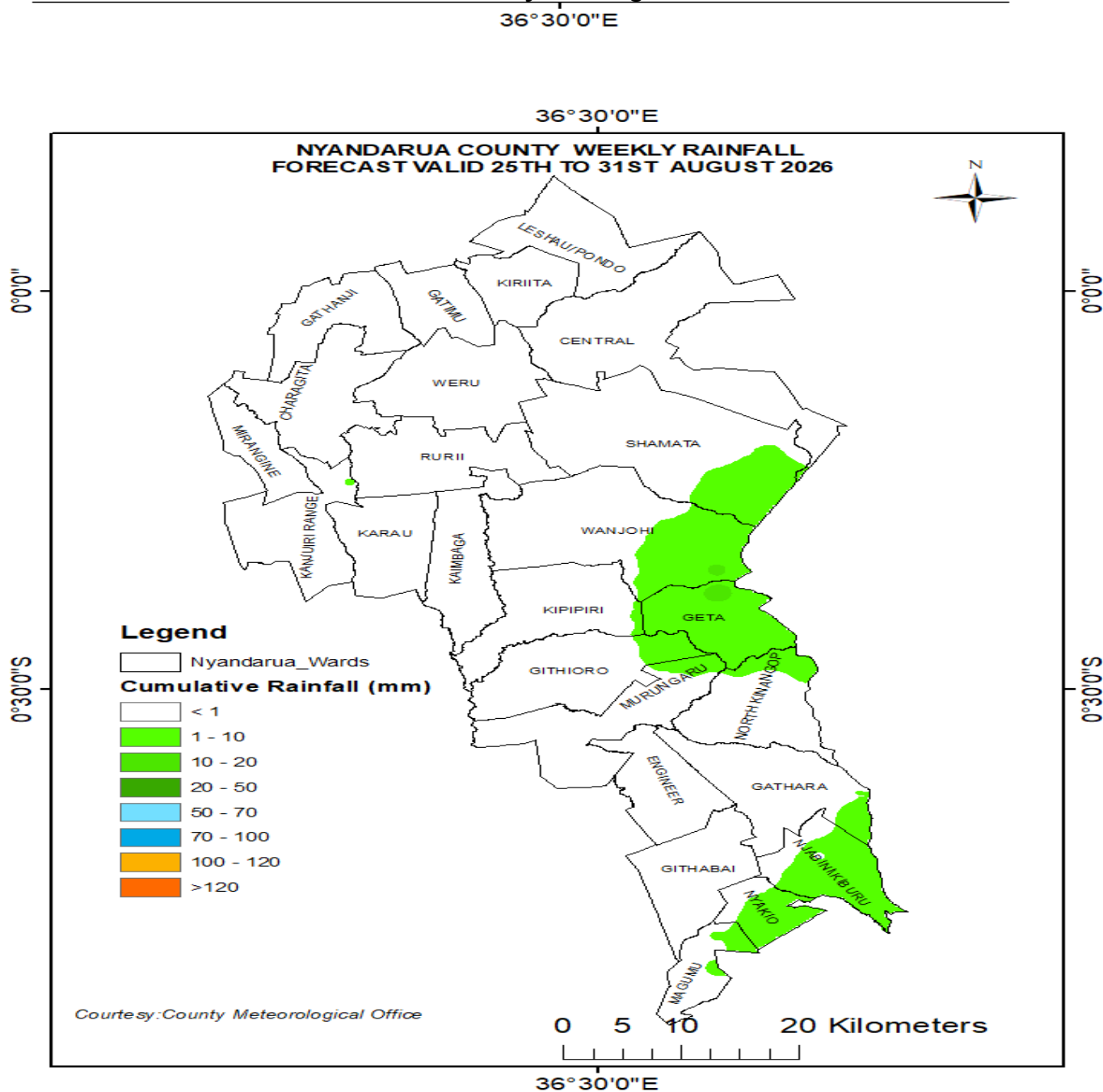

Summary:

The above figure shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nyandarua county is forecasted to receive from **Tuesday 25th to Monday 31st August 2026** (Refer to the legend/key for details on forecasted amounts)

- Parts of Shamata, Wanjohi, Geta, Kipipiri, Githioro, Murungaru, North Kinangop, Gathara, Njabini/Kiburu, Nyakio and Magumu wards are projected to receive weekly cumulative rainfall amounts of between 1 and 10mm.
- The rest of the wards are projected to receive less than 1mm of rainfall cumulatively.
