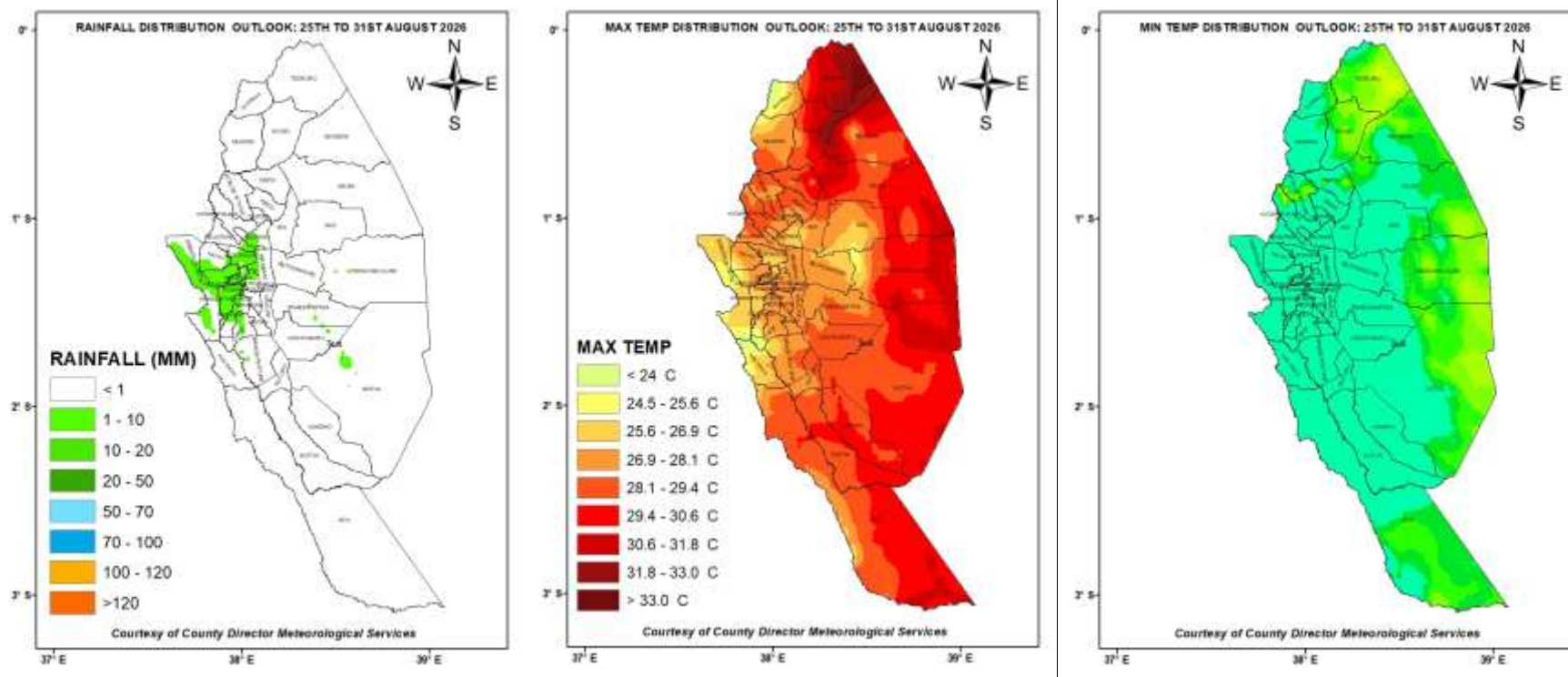


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day Total Rainfall for 25th to 31st August 2026

1.3 WEATHER REVIEW FOR 18TH TO 24TH AUGUST 2026

Most parts of the County were generally dry and partly cloudy both in the morning and afternoon with clear skies at night. There was some light drizzle over high ground areas.

The highest daytime (maximum) temperature was recorded in some parts of Mwingi North (Ngomeni, Tseikuru and Tharaka wards) and Kitui East Sub-counties (Zombe/Mwitika, Voo/Kyamatu and Endau/Malalani wards). The lowest night-time (minimum) temperature was recorded in the hills of Mutonguni Ward and some parts of Kitui Central Sub-county.

1.4 PART II: FURTHER ADVISORIES

SUMMARY ABOUT THE WEEKLY FORECAST:

Partly cloudy conditions in the morning, breaking into sunny intervals the rest of the day in Kitui County. The June-July-August (JJA) cold season has ended.

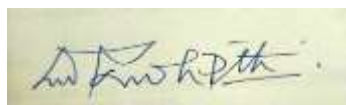
Maximum temperatures are expected to range from 25°C - 35°C, while minimum temperatures are expected to range from 12°C - 22°C and predicted to be warmer than average throughout the County.

Strong southerly to south-easterly winds, with speeds exceeding 25 knots (12.86 m/s), are expected to occur intermittently in some parts of the County.

Community members advised to inculcate the culture of being "weather – ready", "climate – smart" and "water – wise" as we navigate the unfamiliar and chaotic environment of a changing climate. This will help them adapt to a changing climate while at the same time mitigating the adverse effects of Climate Change and Variability, hence becoming more resilient to the vagaries of Climate Change.

In light of this weather forecast, farmers are also advised to consult with respective local extension officers from the County Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock at Ward and Sub-county level for more advice on the best farm harvesting, post-harvest practices and farm preparations for the expected OND 2026 Short-rains associated with El-Nino.

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Annex I: Interpretation of Terms Used

Term	Rainfall Amount (24 hrs)	Description
Light	< 5 mm	Gentle rain, drizzle.
Moderate (MOD)	5–20 mm	Steady, noticeable rain.
Heavy (HV)	21–50 mm	Intense rain, possible thunder.
Very Heavy (VHV)	> 50 mm	Prolonged rain.

Term	Area Affected	Description
Few places	< 33%	Rain in a small portion of the region.
Several places	33% to 66%	Rain in multiple but not most parts of the region.
Most places	> 66%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.

Term	Area Affected	Description
Isolated	Less than 25%	Very few areas affected.
Scattered	25–50%	Several, but not most, areas affected.
Numerous	51–70%	Many areas affected.
Widespread	Over 70%	Almost all areas affected.

Term	Time Coverage (%)	Meaning
Occasional	Less than 25%	Happens rarely or a few times.
Intermittent	25% – 50%	Starts and stops, comes and goes.
Frequent	51% – 75%	Occurs regularly.
Very Frequent/Common	More than 75%	Happens almost all the time.

Term	Probability of Occurrence	Description
Possible	10–30%	There is low confidence.
Chance of/May	31–50%	There is moderate confidence.
Likely	51–75%	The event is more probable than not.
Expected	76–90%	There is high confidence.
Very Likely	91–99%	There is very high confidence. Almost certain.
Certain	100%	The event is guaranteed to occur.

Note: 1 mm of rainfall is equivalent to 1 litre of rainfall per square meter.
