



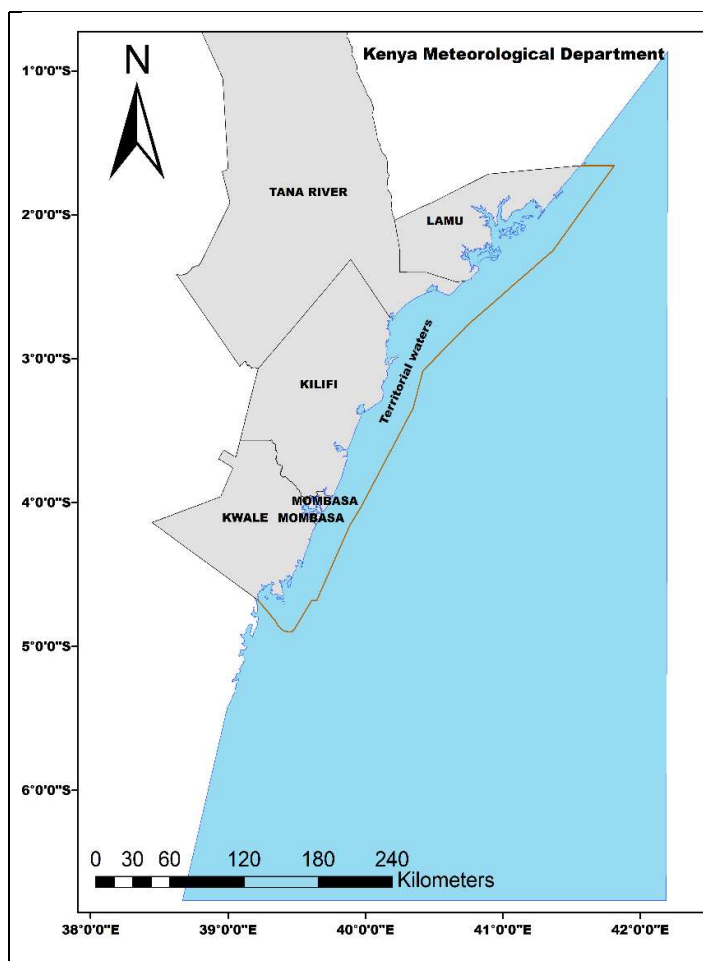
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DAILY MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST FOR KENYAN COAST

Issued at: 1500 EAT on 31st August, 2026

Valid: 0000 EAT on 1st September, 2026 to 0000 EAT on 2nd September 2026.



GENERAL OUTLOOK

Morning sea state:

- Light to Breezy S winds (09-19knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 6-8ft (1.8-2.4m) with moderate to large mid waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Afternoon sea state:

- Breezy to strong SSE to South winds (12-19knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 5-7ft (1.5-2.1m) with moderate to large mid waves of (10sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

Visibility:

- Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST

i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: S 9 to 12 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 6 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 13 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:22AM** and sunset: **6:24PM**
- Visibility: Moderate (**9-10 km**)
- High Tide: **6:19AM;3.63m, 6:31PM;3.25m**
- Low Tide: **00:06AM;0.24m, 12:32PM;0.38m**

ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: S 11 to 15 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 8 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 13 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong SSE winds with choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:20AM** and sunset: **6:22PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10 km)**
- High Tide: **6:26AM;3.54m, 6:41PM;3.16m**
- Low Tide: **00:07AM;0.2m, 12:33PM;0.3m**

iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: S 11 to 17 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 8 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 14 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong SSE winds with choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:20AM** and Sunset: **6:22PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **6:14AM;3.3m, 6:26PM;2.89m**
- Low Tide: **12:26PM;0.23m**

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 12 to 19 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 12 to 18 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Large mid period waves.
- Sunrise: **6:14AM** and Sunset: **6:18PM**
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: **6:15AM;3.17m, 6:26PM;2.76m**
- Low Tide: **00:00AM;0.10m, 12:28PM;0.22m**

Advisory

- Moderate sea conditions are expected with a significant wave height of **1.5m-2.4m** in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Gentle to fresh breeze of **09-19knots** expected in Kwale, Mombasa Kilifi and Lamu throughout the forecast period. **Small boats and crafts are advised to be cautious while venturing into deep sea areas.**

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 6 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – $\geq$ 34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!
