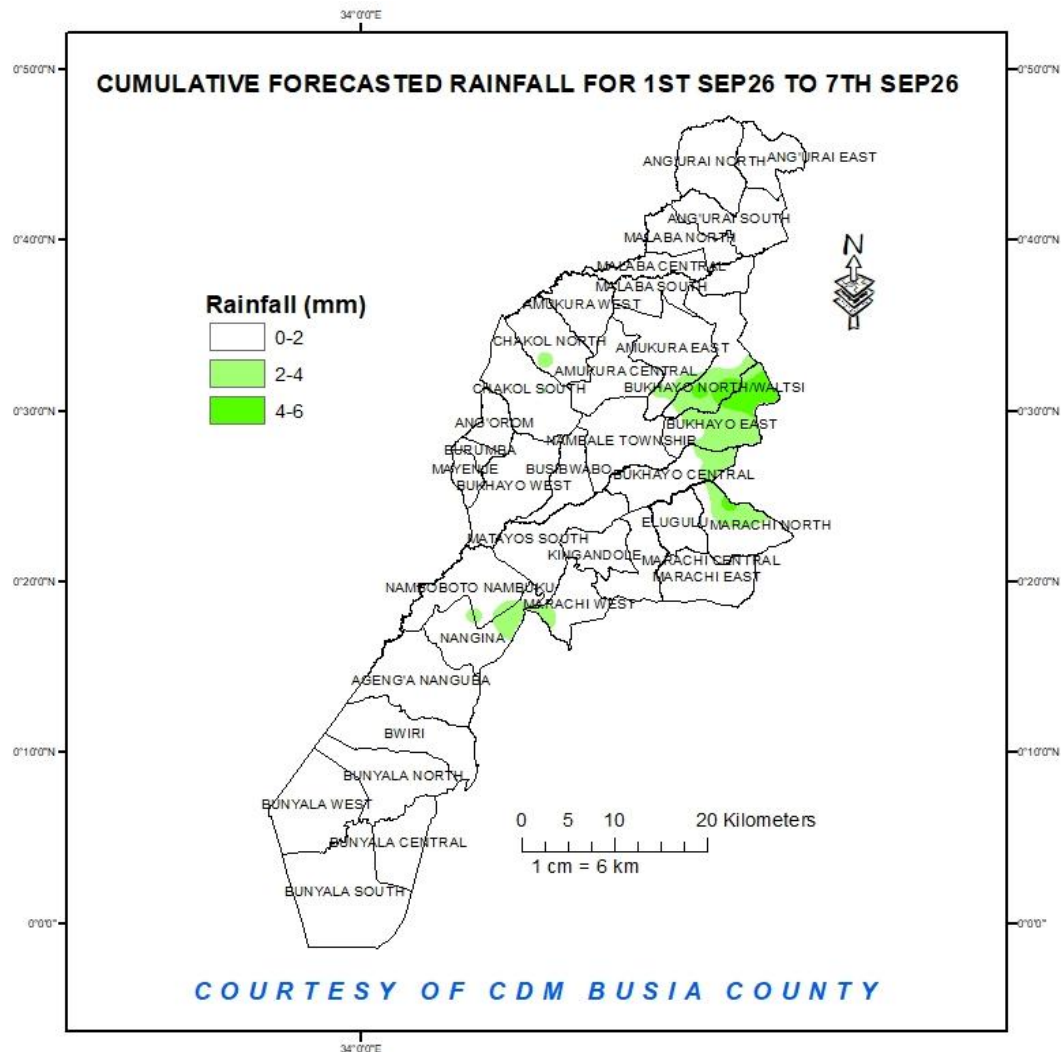

Date of issue: Monday 31st August 2026

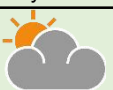
Summary

Busia County is expected to remain mainly dry during the coming week. There is a possibility of few clouds in the sky with a lot of sunshine. Daytime temperatures are expected to be less hot during the day with afternoon highs getting to 31°C versus 33°C recorded last week. The nights are expected to feel slightly warmer than last week, with lows 18°C. A few places may receive light afternoon accompanied with lightning and rumbles of thunder especially on Sunday and Monday especially in Teso South, Samia, Nambale and Butula sub-counties. But even here, the possible showers will be isolated, with many places remaining dry.

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

- Water Vegetables thoroughly in the evenings so that they utilize the water during the cooler nights.

- Harvest rainwater and store it safely for future use in case it rains over your area.
- Work under tree shade in the afternoon whenever it feels hot.
- Seek further guidance from agriculture extension officers in your ward on farm activities.
