Period of forecast: Tuesday 7th September to Monday 14th September 2026

Date of issue: Monday 7th September 2026

General Outlook/Summary.

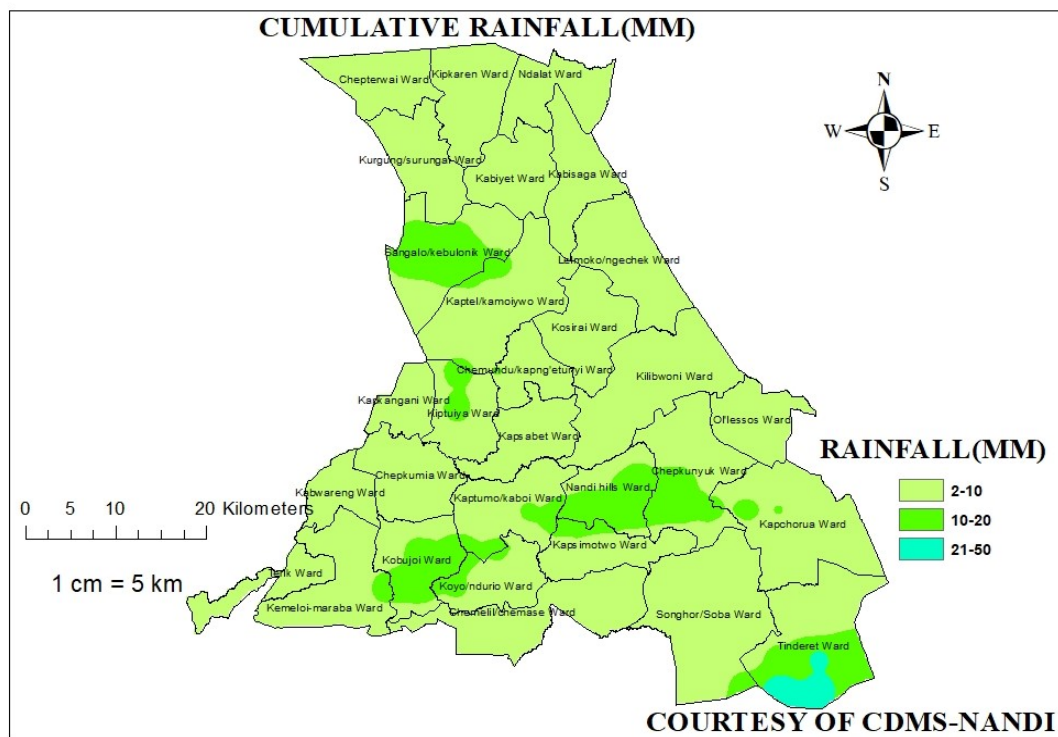


Figure 1: Cumulative rainfall forecast over Nandi County valid 8th -14TH Sept 2026

Nandi County will experience an improved rainfall across almost all of its coverage, although the amounts remain largely light rainfall of <5mm in many places with few places experiencing moderate rainfall of 5mm-20mm. Heavy rainfall likely to be experienced in Tenderet ward as shown in figure 1. Temperature range is likely to be between 12-33°C. With maximum temperatures ranging 26-33°C and low temperatures ranging 12-21 °C.

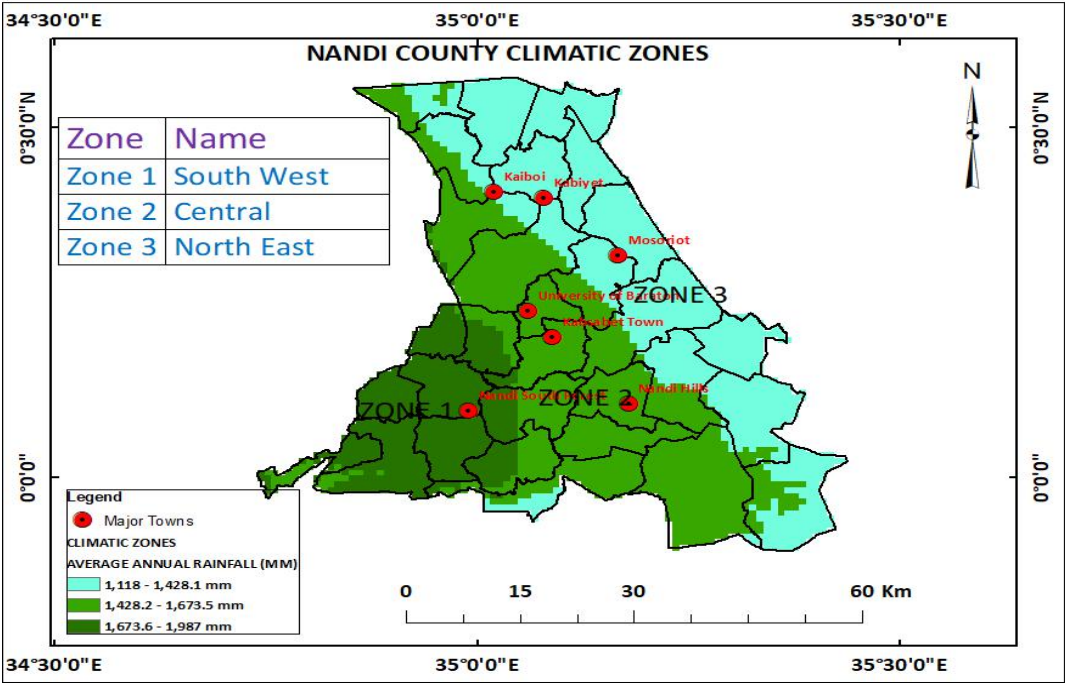


Figure 2: Climatic zones in Nandi County

- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature ranges likely to be 26-33°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 12°- 21°C during the forecast period

APPENDIX I: INTERPRETATION OF TERM

S/No	Term	Rainfall Amount (24 hrs)	Description
1	Light	< 5mm	Gentle rain, drizzle.

2	Moderate/Lingering	5 - 20 mm	Steady, noticeable rain.
3	Heavy	21 - 50 mm	Intense rain, possible thunder.
4	Very heavy	> 50 mm	Prolonged rain, high intensity.

S/No	Term	Area Affected	Description
1	Few places	< 33%	Rain in a small portion of the region.
2	Several places	33% - 66%	Rain in multiple but not in most parts of the region.
3	Most places	> 66%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.

S/No	Term	Probability of Occurrence	Description
1	Possible	10% - 30%	There is low confidence.
2	Chance of/May	31% - 50%	There is moderate confidence.
3	Likely	51% - 75%	There event is more probable than not.
4	Expected	76% - 90%	There is high confidence.
5	Very likely	91% - 99%	There is very high confidence. Almost certain.
6	Certain	100%	The event is guaranteed to occur.
