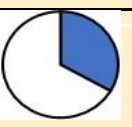
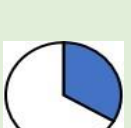

Summary

Figure1 above shows the weekly cumulative volume of rainfall amounts each region in Nakuru county is forecasted to receive from **Tuesday 8th to Monday 14th September 2026** (Refer to the Figure legend/key for details of forecasted rainfall amounts).

- Detailed forecast in the climatic zone tables 1-3 above indicates that most parts of Kiptagich and Amalo wards are projected to receive the highest cumulative weekly rainfall of between 20 and 50mm.
- Solai, Wasenges, Subukia, Kihingo, Barut, Elementaita and Maiella wards are projected to receive the least cumulative weekly rainfall of less than 1mm.
- The rest of the wards are projected to receive cumulative weekly rainfall of between 1 and 20mm.
- Overall, majority of the wards are projected to receive morning rains and afternoon and/or night showers over few places during the forecast period.
- Areas over large water bodies like lakes Nakuru and Naivasha and their environs (which includes the City and Naivasha town) may occasionally experience afternoon/evening showers over few to several places due to local climatological effects.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Partly cloudy conditions with rains over few places in the morning hours.
- Showers expected over few places in the afternoon/evening hours.
- Partly cloudy nights with showers over few places expected during the forecast period.

Advice to farmers from the Ministry & Department of Agriculture:

Highly consider to always consult your local agricultural extension officer for advice on how to plan your farming activities in light of this forecast.
