WEEKLY WEATHER FORECAST FOR 29TH SEPTEMBER TO 5TH OCTOBER 2026
AND
REVIEW FOR 21ST TO 27TH SEPTEMBER 2026

SUMMARY

Weather Forecast for 29th September to 5th October 2026

- Rainfall is expected in parts of Lamu, Kwale, Kilifi, Mombasa, Tana River, Taita Taveta, Mandera, Marsabit, Meru, Embu, Garissa, Kiambu, Kirinyaga, Kisumu, Kitui, Laikipia, Machakos, Makueni, Murang'a, Nairobi, Nakuru, Nyandarua, Nyeri, Tharaka-Nithi, Trans Nzoia, Bungoma, Elgeyo Marakwet, Bomet, Kericho, Kisii, Nyamira and Wajir Counties.

Weather Review for 21st to 27th September 2026

- The highest seven-day rainfall total (125.1mm) was recorded at Kibabii University Rainfall station, Bungoma.
- Mandera Meteorological Station recorded the highest daily maximum temperature: 38.3°C on 27th September 2026.
- Nyahururu Meteorological Station recorded the lowest daily minimum temperature: 5.1°C on 27th September 2026.

1.0 WEATHER FORECAST FOR 29TH SEPTEMBER TO 5TH OCTOBER 2026

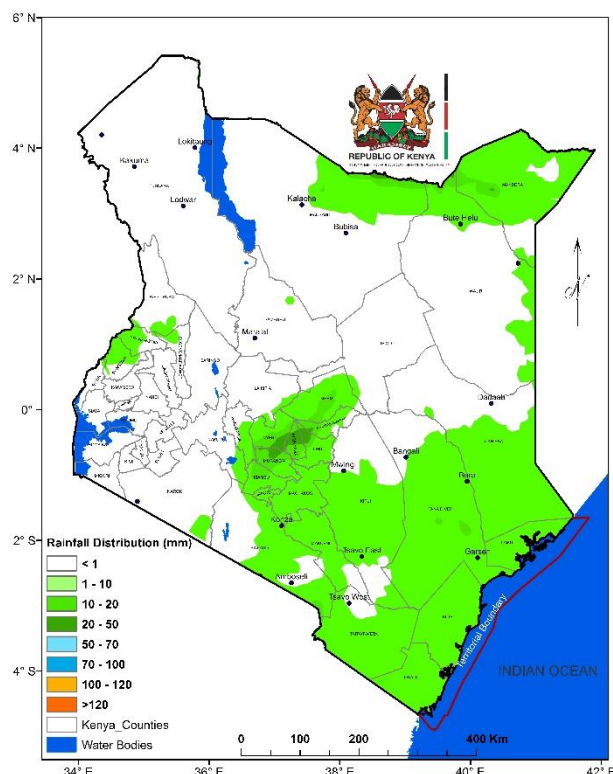


Figure 1: Forecasted seven-day total rainfall for 29th September to 5th October 2026

Rainfall is expected in parts of Lamu, Kwale, Kilifi, Mombasa, Tana River, Taita Taveta, Mandera, Marsabit, Meru, Embu, Garissa, Kiambu, Kirinyaga, Kisumu, Kitui, Laikipia, Machakos, Makueni, Murang'a, Nairobi, Nakuru, Nyandarua, Nyeri, Tharaka-Nithi, Trans Nzoia, Bungoma, Elgeyo Marakwet, Bomet, Kericho, Kisii, Nyamira and Wajir Counties. (Figure 1).

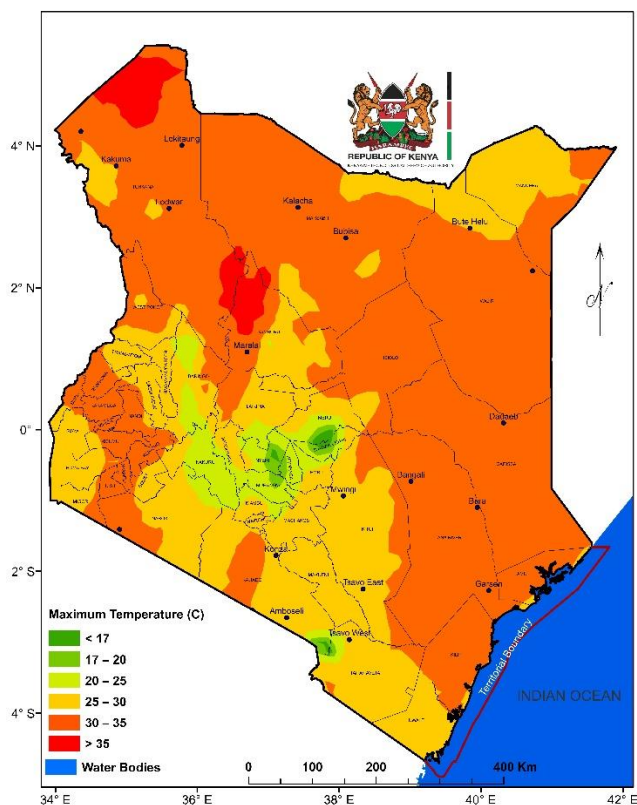


Figure 2: Forecasted average maximum temperatures for 29th September to 5th October 2026

Daytime (maximum) average temperatures of more than 30°C are expected several counties including Kilifi, Tana River, Lamu, Garissa, Wajir, Isiolo, Bungoma, Busia, Kakamega, Marsabit and Turkana (Figure 2).

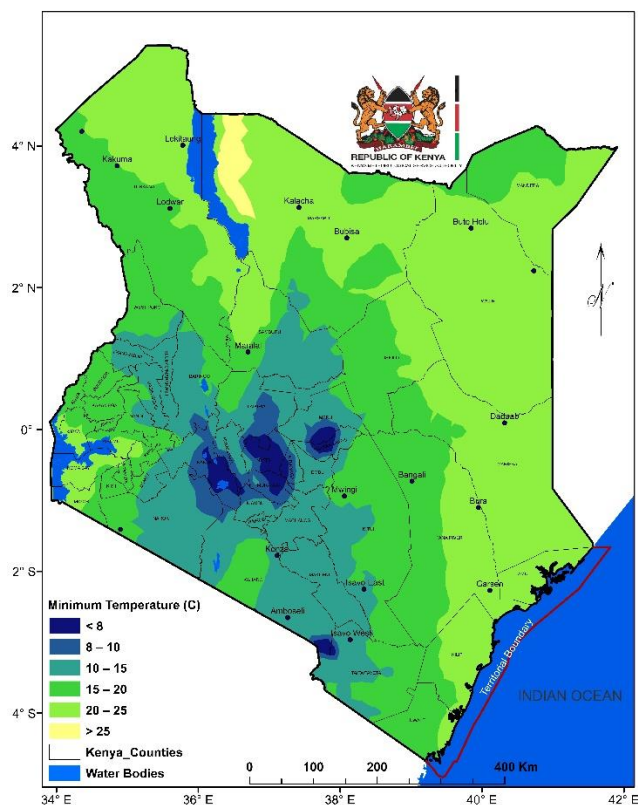


Figure 3: Forecasted average minimum temperatures for 29th September to 5th October 2026

Night-time (minimum) average temperatures are expected to be less than 10°C in some parts of Meru, Tharaka-Nithi, Kirinyaga, Murang'a, Nyeri, Nakuru, Nyandarua, Laikipia, Narok, Taita Taveta and Kajiado Counties (Figure 3).

1.1 DETAILED COUNTY RAINFALL FORECAST FOR 29TH SEPTEMBER TO 5TH OCTOBER 2026

- 1.1.1 Morning showers are expected in a few areas, occasionally spreading to several parts of Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi, Tana River, and Lamu counties.
- 1.1.2 Morning rains may occur in a few parts of Marsabit, Wajir, Garissa, Mandera, Nairobi, Taita Taveta, Nyandarua, Nakuru, Kiambu, Machakos, Murang'a, Kirinyaga, Embu, Meru, Nyeri and Tharaka-Nithi Counties.
- 1.1.3 Sunny intervals are expected in the mornings in most parts of Baringo, Bomet, Bungoma, Busia, Elgeyo Marakwet, Homa Bay, Isiolo, Kajiado, Kakamega, Kericho, Kisii, Kisumu, Kitui, Laikipia, Makueni, Migori, Nandi, Narok, Nyamira, Samburu, Siaya, Trans Nzoia, Turkana, Uasin Gishu, Vihiga and West Pokot Counties.
- 1.1.4 Afternoon showers and thunderstorms are likely to occur in a few parts of Bomet, Bungoma, Busia, Homa Bay, Kakamega, Kericho, Kisii, Kisumu, Migori, Nakuru, Nandi, Narok, Nyamira, Siaya, Elgeyo Marakwet, Trans Nzoia and Vihiga Counties.
- 1.1.5 Afternoon showers may occur in a few parts of Embu, Garissa, Wajir, Marsabit, Mandera, Kiambu, Kilifi, Kirinyaga, Kitui, Kwale, Laikipia, Lamu, Machakos, Makueni, Meru, Mombasa, Murang'a, Nairobi, Nyandarua, Nyeri, Taita Taveta, Kajiado, Tana River and Tharaka-Nithi Counties.
- 1.1.6 Sunny intervals are expected in the afternoons in most parts of Baringo, Isiolo, Samburu, Turkana, Vihiga, Uasin Gishu and West Pokot Counties.
- 1.1.7 Night showers may occur in a few parts of Kilifi, Kwale, Lamu, Mombasa, Tana River, Taita Taveta, Mandera, Marsabit, Wajir, Garissa, Nairobi, Embu, Meru, Nakuru, Busia, Kisumu, Isiolo, Elgeyo Marakwet and Bungoma Counties.
- 1.1.8 Partly cloudy conditions are expected at night in most parts of Baringo, Bomet, Kakamega, Homa Bay, Isiolo, Kajiado, Kericho, Kiambu, Kirinyaga, Kisii, Kitui, Laikipia, Machakos, Makueni, Migori, Murang'a, Nandi, Narok, Nyamira, Nyandarua, Nyeri, Samburu, Siaya, Tharaka-Nithi, Trans Nzoia, Turkana, Uasin Gishu and West Pokot Counties.

1.2 DETAILED TEMPERATURE FORECAST FOR 29TH SEPTEMBER TO 5TH OCTOBER 2026

Expected maximum and minimum temperatures for selected cities and towns are shown in Table 1.

2.0 WEATHER REVIEW FOR 21ST TO 27TH SEPTEMBER 2026

2.1 Rainfall Review

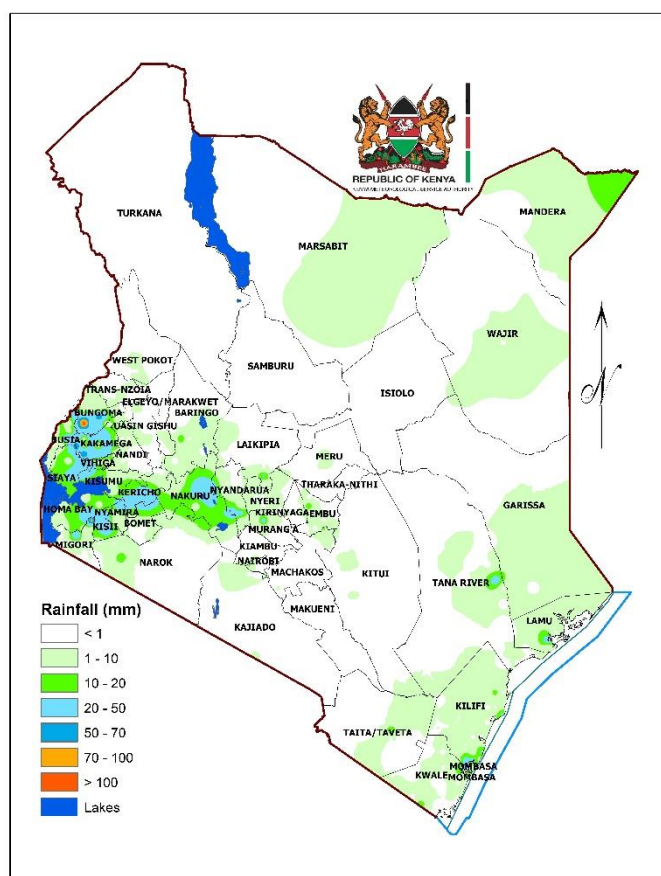


Figure 4: Observed seven-day total rainfall for 21st to 27th September 2026

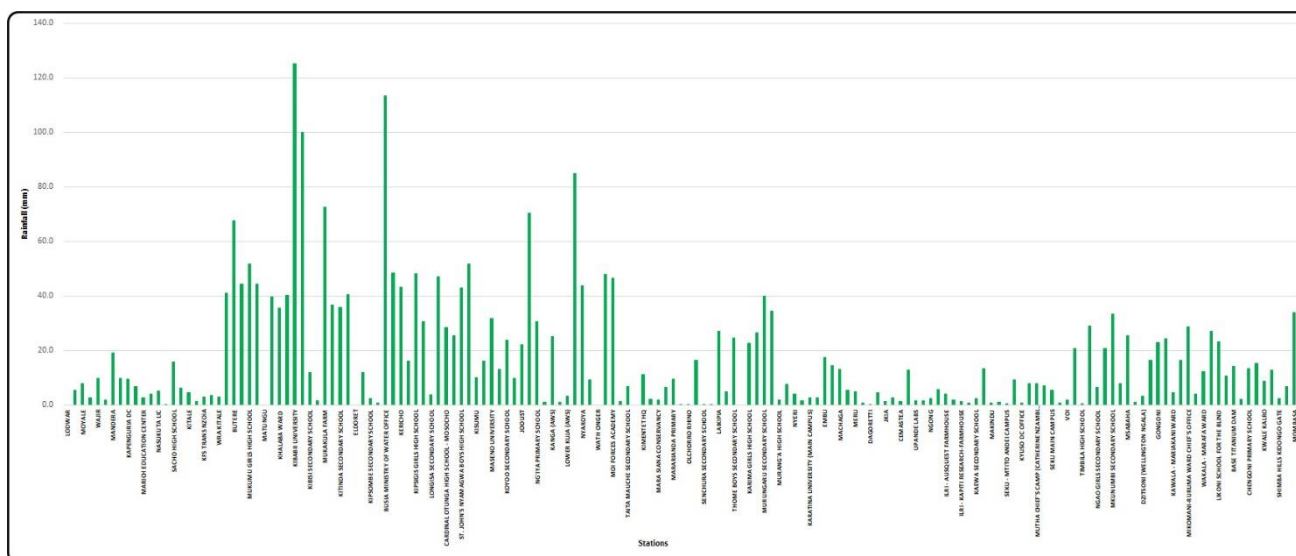


Figure 5: Observed seven-day total rainfall (per station) for 21st to 27th September 2026

Rainfall was recorded in several counties including Bungoma, Busia, Migori, Siaya, Nyamira, Kakamega, Kisii, Nakuru and Kericho (Figures 4 and 5).

The highest seven-day rainfall total (125.1mm) was recorded at Kibabii University Rainfall station at, Bungoma.

Miyare Rainfall Station in Migori County recorded the highest rainfall amount within 24-hours: 61.2mm on 21st September 2026.

Comparing 14th to 20th September 2026 and the 21st to 27th September 2026 review periods, it is noted that rainfall amounts decreased in several counties such as Lamu, Kilifi, Kwale, Mombasa and Uasin Gishu among others.

2.1 Temperature Review

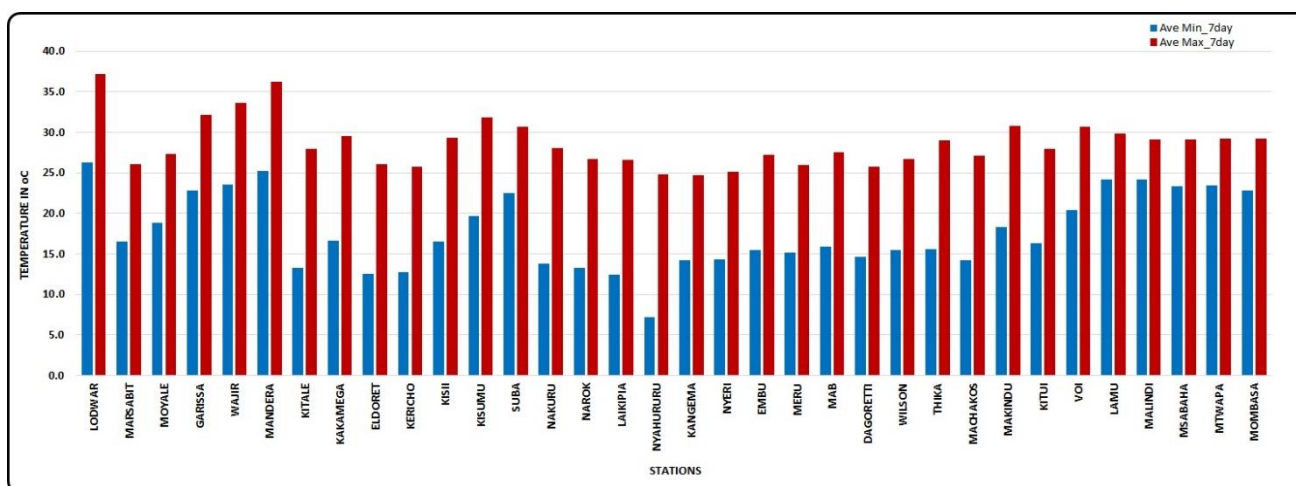


Figure 6: Seven-day average maximum and minimum temperatures for 21st to 27th September 2026

Mandera Meteorological Station recorded the highest daily maximum temperature: 38.3°C on 27th September 2026 while Nyahururu Meteorological Station recorded the lowest daily minimum temperature: 5.1°C on the same day. Lodwar Meteorological Station recorded the highest seven-day average maximum temperature: 37.2°C while Nyahururu recorded the lowest seven-day average minimum temperature: 7.2°C (Figure 6).

Comparing the 14th to 20th September 2026 and the 21st to 27th September 2026 review periods, it is noted that daytime (maximum) temperatures increased in most stations though a few such as Moyale, Mandera, Wajir and Garissa recorded a decrease. Night-time (minimum) temperatures increased in several stations across the Country except Kabete, Narok, Garissa and Lamu among others, that recorded a decrease.

N.B: This forecast should be used in conjunction with the daily (24-hour) and five-day forecasts issued by this Department. County specific forecasts are available from the offices of respective County Directors of Meteorological Services.

APPENDIX I: INTERPRETATION OF TERMS USED

Term	Rainfall Amount (24 hrs.)	Description
Light	< 5 mm	Gentle rain, drizzle.
Moderate	5–20 mm	Steady, noticeable rain.
Heavy	21–50 mm	Intense rain, possible thunder.
Very Heavy	> 50 mm	Prolonged rain, high intensity.

Term	Area Affected	Description
Few places	< 33%	Rain in a small portion of the region.
Several places	33% to 66%	Rain in multiple but not most parts of the region.
Most places	> 66%	Rain in nearly all parts of the region.

Term	Area Affected	Description
Isolated	Less than 25%	Very few areas affected.
Scattered	25–50%	Several, but not most, areas affected.
Numerous	51–70%	Many areas affected.
Widespread	Over 70%	Almost all areas affected.

Term	Time Coverage (%)	Meaning
Occasional	Less than 25%	Happens rarely or a few times.
Intermittent	25% – 50%	Starts and stops, comes and goes.
Frequent	51% – 75%	Occurs regularly.
Very Frequent / Common	More than 75%	Happens almost all the time.

Term	Probability of Occurrence	Description
Possible	10–30%	There is low confidence.
Chance of/ May	31–50%	There is moderate confidence.
Likely	51–75%	The event is more probable than not.
Expected	76–90%	There is high confidence.
Very Likely	91–99%	There is very high confidence. Almost certain.
Certain	100%	The event is guaranteed to occur.
