

## **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

### Morning sea state:

Light and variable winds (04-12 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3-4 feet (0.9m - 1.2m) with small period waves of (7-8 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### Afternoon sea state:

Light E to SE winds (07-17 knots) with slight choppy seas. ESE waves of 3- feet (0.9m - 1.2m) with small period waves of (7-sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### **Visibility:**

• Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

- Afternoon Winds: SSE 12 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 5:57AM and sunset; 6:15PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 06:24AM; 2.9m, 06:40PM; 3.4m
- Low Tide; 12:18PM; 0.2m

#### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 4 to 6 knots.
- Morning Waves: SE 4 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small short period waves
- Afternoon Winds: SE 7 to 11 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 3 feet at 7 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light SE winds with a slight chop. Very small short period waves.
- Sunrise; 00.38AM and sunset; 6:10PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 06.24AM; 2.7m, 06.41 PM; 3.3m,
- Low Tide: 12:18PM; 0.2m,

# **Advisory**

- Relatively calm conditions are expected with a significant wave height of 0.9m to 1.2m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Calm breeze to Fresh breeze of (04-17 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
