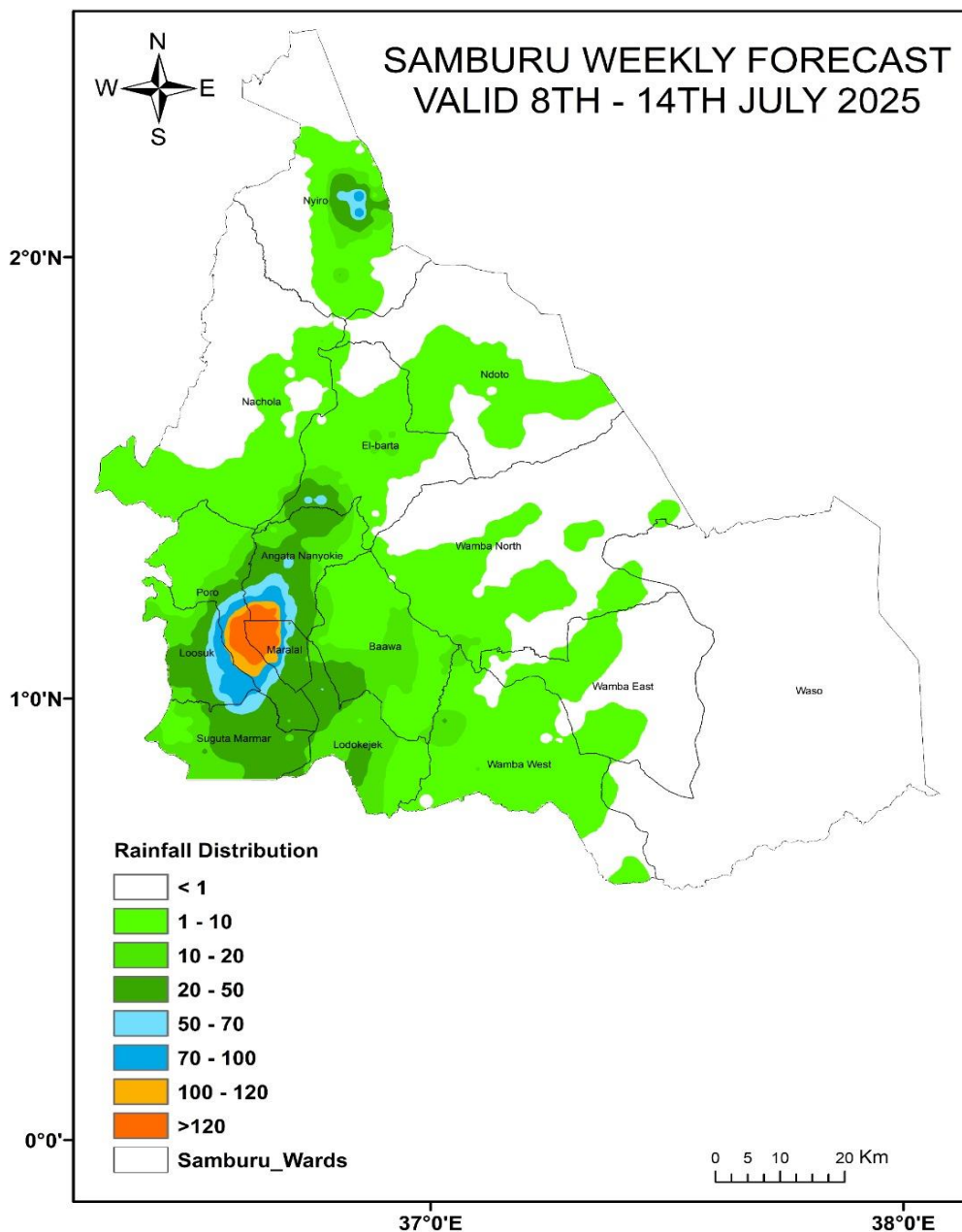


Figure1:Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 8th to 14th July, 2025. Few wards are anticipated to be wet during the course of the forecast period.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights. However, Mararal, Suguta MarMar, Porro, Baawa, Lodokejek, Loosuk and Angata Nanyokie are expected to experience wet conditions.

- ❖ Few wards anticipated to experience wet conditions
- ❖ Sunny days and partly cloudy nights
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 29.0°C and 32.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 19.0°C and 21.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 14th to 20th July, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience wet weather conditions over few areas.
