WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE NEXT SEVEN DAYS VALID 08 - 14 July, 2025

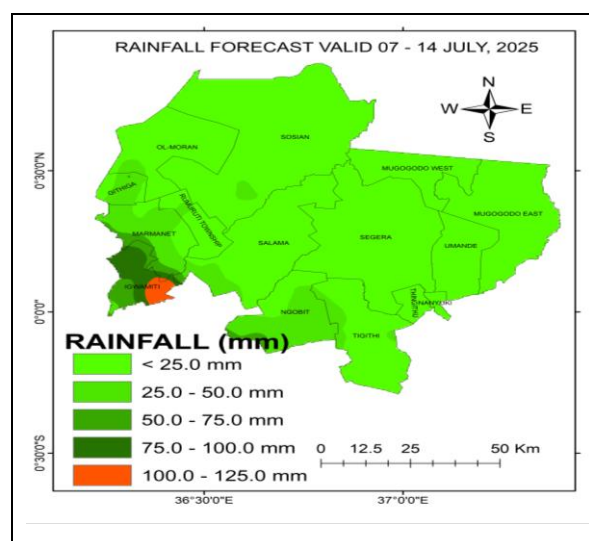
Forecast for the next Seven days (08 - 14 - July, 2025) indicates;

- Rainfall expected over several places
- Expect mainly cloudy mornings, afternoon showers and thunderstorms over few places
- The Maximum temperatures expected to range between 20 - 25°C and the (Minimum) temperatures to range 06 - 20°C

Review of weather for the last seven-days (01 – 07 July, 2025)

- Stations that recorded rains includes, Tigithi, Mugie, Ol Pejeta, Nanyuki, Ngobit etc
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased over most places.*
- Both the day time (Max) temperatures and the Night time (Min) temperatures increased

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days (08 - 14 July, 2025)



Expect mainly clouds with light rains in the morning with afternoon showers & thunderstorms over Few Places

Between 10 - 100mm of cumulated weekly rainfall is expected over several places as indicated in the adjacent rainfall forecast map.

Note; much of the predicted rains are likely in the second half of the forecasting period.
