

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that several places are likely to receive light to moderate rainfall. Temperatures in several places are expected to increase slightly during the day and at night.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience cold and cloudy conditions especially at the beginning of the forecast period. However few places will experience sunny intervals.
- In the afternoon several places are likely to experience light to moderate rainfall.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy. However, few places may receive light rainfall.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 24 and 26 degrees Celsius.

 Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 14 and 16 degrees Celsius.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to avoid being struck by lightning.
- Take advantage of the rainfall and plant food crops and trees.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
