

Weekly Weather forecast for Kilifi County valid 15th to 21st July, 2025 PART I: Weekly weather forecast summary

- > The County is expected to receive light occasional showers over few places especially on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday.
- A few areas in Malindi and Kilifi south subcounties have a chance of receiving occasional light showers on Tuesday.
- Mainly Sunny conditions expected from Saturday to Monday.
- ➤ Maximum/Daytime temperatures are expected to range from 27–30 °C in areas within the coastline and 28-31 °C in the hinterlands.
- ➤ The Minimum/Night temperatures are expected to range from 21-24 °C in areas within the coastline and 21-23 °C in the hinterlands.
- ➤ Inland winds are expected to improve from Wednesday, with mainly moderate to strong winds the entire county.
- There's need for caution in especially Magarini, Malindi, Ganze and Kilifi North sub counties on Tuesday.
- > Ocean conditions are expected to improve from Wednesday to Friday then slightly deteriorate from Saturday to Monday.
- Moderate to Rough Ocean conditions are expected this week with wind speeds ranging from 15-28Knots.
- Users of small vessels are advised to avoid venturing deepsea on Tuesday due to strong winds.
- Users of small vessels are advised to venture with caution due to moderate to strong winds the rest of the week.
- Any significant change in the forecast will be shared in your WhatsApp groups

PART II: Meteorological advice to farmers concerning June to August KUSI season

- > The JJA season is expected to be characterized by near average rainfall in areas within the coastline (semi humid semi arid lands of Kilifi).
- > July is expected to receive near normal rainfall amounts.
- Forecast for July indicate that, areas within the coastline and parts of semi-arid lands of the hinterlands are expected to receive near average rainfall.
- > Temperatures in JJA are expected to be higher than the climatological average, although maintain lower than the rest of the year records.
- > The month of July marks the middle of the KUSI/JJA season –controlled by strong summer monsoons.
- ➤ General public and ocean users are advised to be cautious of chilly conditions and strong winds occasionally influenced by the monsoons.
- > Farmers are advised to take advantage of the near average rains and plant the recommended crops and trees.
