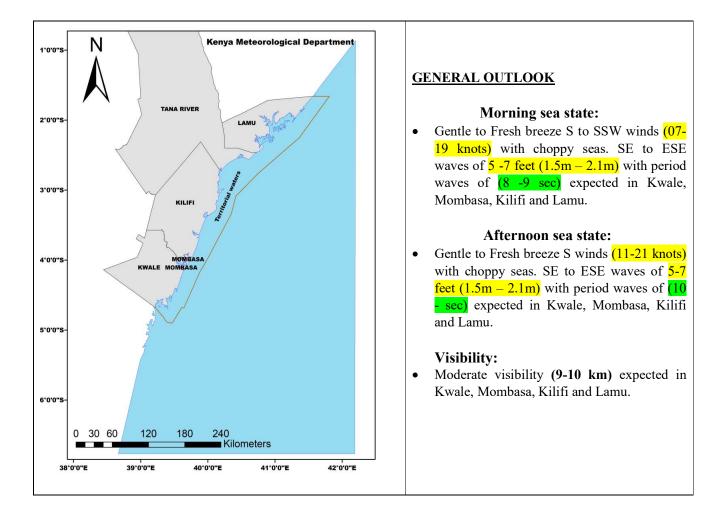

i. <u>KWALE</u>

- Morning Winds: S 17 to 19 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 9 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Small short period waves
- Afternoon Winds: S 15 to 21 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Moderate to strong S winds with choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 06:32AM and sunset; 06:27PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)

- Morning sea state: Light SSW winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 12 to 19 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; 06:29AM and sunset; 06:26PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 02:59AM; 2.3m, 03:08PM; 3.1m,
- Low Tide; 08:38AM; 0.7m; 09:43PM; 0.3m;

iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 8 to 18 knots.
- Morning Waves: SE 7 feet at 8 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Moderate short period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 11 to 20 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: SE 7 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid period waves.
- Sunrise; Sunrise; 06:22AM and sunset; 06:23PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 02.59AM; 2.2m, 03.08PM; 3.0m
- Low Tide: 08:38AM; 0.7m, 09:45PM; 0.3m

<u>Advisory</u>

- Moderate Sea conditions are expected with a wave height of 1.5m 2.1m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu. Caution on operating marine activities.

KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	< 1 – 7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7 – 17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 – ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
