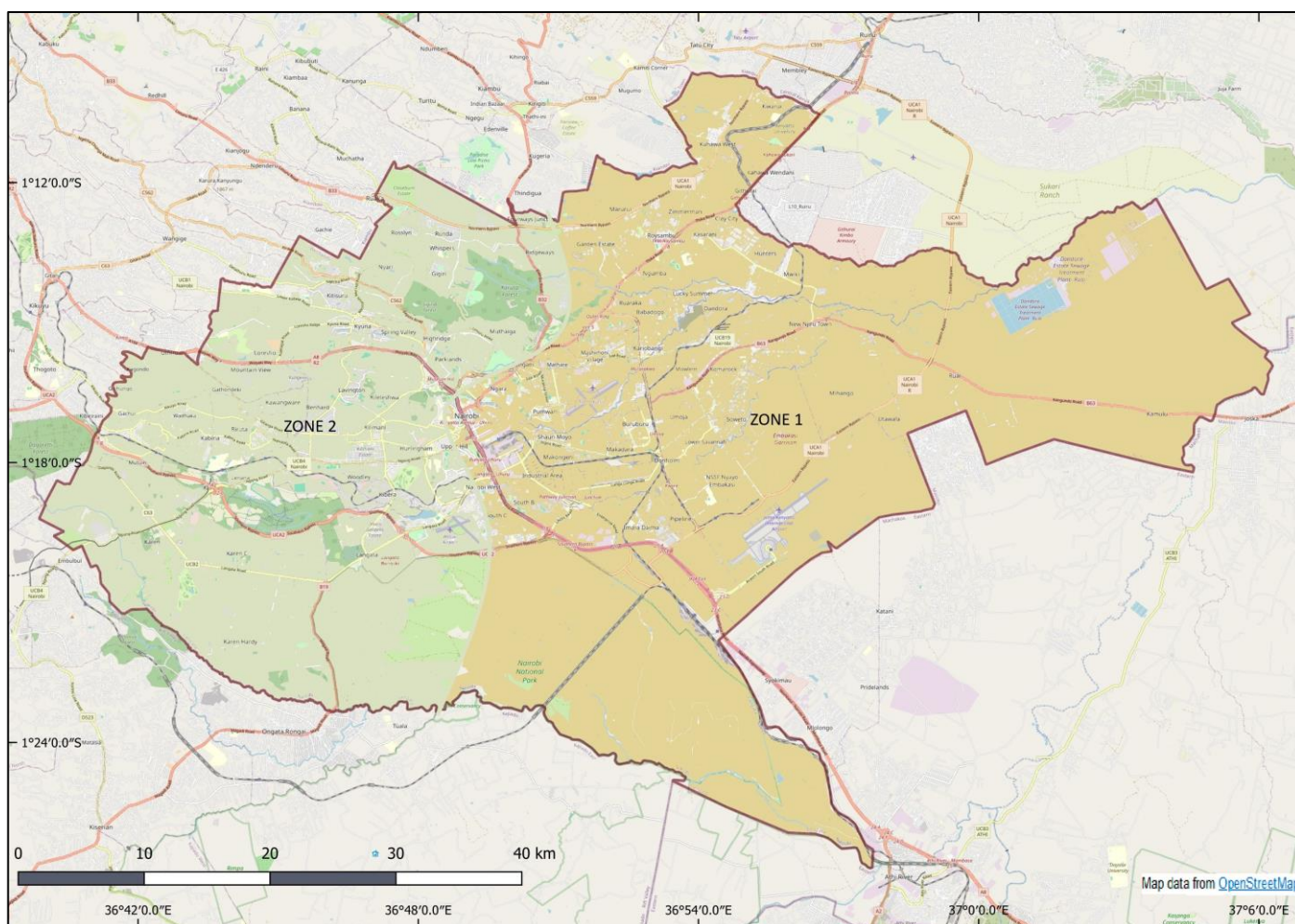









### SUMMARY:

| <b>Term</b>       | <b>Rainfall Amount (24 hrs.)</b> | <b>Description</b>              |
|-------------------|----------------------------------|---------------------------------|
| <b>Light</b>      | < 5 mm                           | Gentle rain, drizzle.           |
| <b>Moderate</b>   | 5–20 mm                          | Steady, noticeable rain.        |
| <b>Heavy</b>      | 21–50 mm                         | Intense rain, possible thunder. |
| <b>Very Heavy</b> | > 50 mm                          | Prolonged rain.                 |
