


Figure 1: Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms over the following wards **Loosuk,Maralal,Sunguta Marmar,Lodokejek** and parts of **Nachola,Baawa** and **Poro**.

- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 30.0°C and 32.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 18.0°C and 19.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 12^{th} to 17^{th} August, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience wet weather conditions over few areas
