SIAYA COUNTY CLIMATOLOGICAL MAP

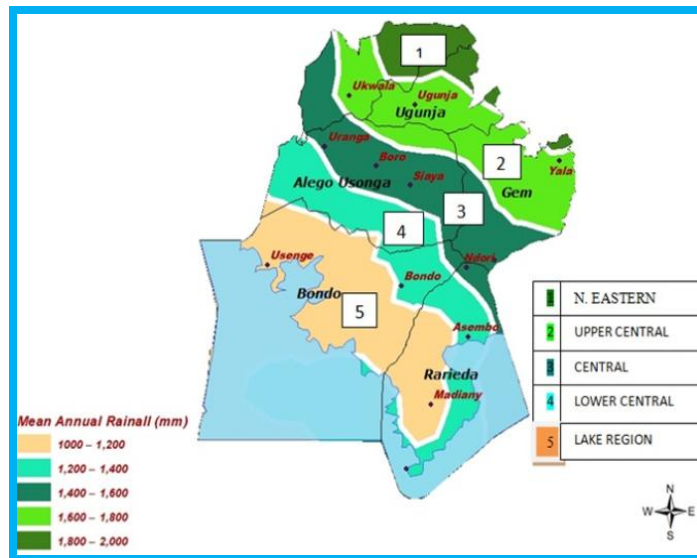


Figure 1; Siaya County Long Term Mean rainfall (Climatological) Map

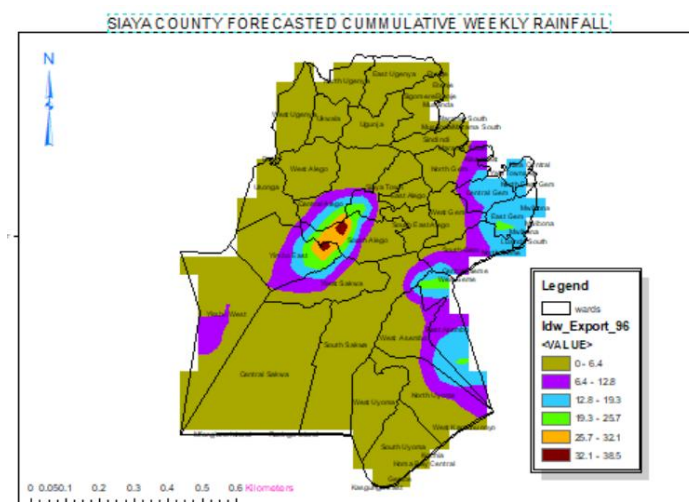


Figure 2: Forecasted cumulative weekly rainfall from 5th to 11th August 2025

Figure 2 above shows the map for cumulative weekly rainfall ranging from 0.0mm to 38.5mm. Most parts of the county are expected to experience between 0.0mm and 6.4mm. Some wards in the Central and Eastern part of the County are likely to experience between 6.4mm and 38.5mm

Period of forecast: Tuesday August 5th to Monday 11th August 2025
Date of issue: Monday 4th August 2025

Summary

Regions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5; morning showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Afternoon/night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Temperatures of between 27°C and 24°C during the day and between 19°C and 18°C during the night likely. Moderate/strong winds more so over Lake Victoria likely throughout the forecast period

Hazard Symbols

Green – No hazard warnings in force.

Amber - Potentially dangerous weather is expected. **Be prepared.**

Red – Dangerous and potentially life threatening weather conditions are expected. **Take immediate and appropriate action to ensure your safety.**

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- ✓ Morning/afternoon showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Saturday, Sunday and Monday
- ✓ Night showers associated with lightning and thunderstorms over many places likely on Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday

Advice to farmers from Ministry of Agriculture

- Planting of vegetables by watering
- Spraying of animals against pests
- Report anything unusual to the agriculture or veterinary/livestock experts

Health Advisories (*courtesy of One Health Program*)

- Safe drinking water; Ensure your water source is safe
- Mosquito protection; Ensure you sleep under mosquito net or use repellent
- Proper hygiene; Maintain good personal hygiene i.e use of toilet and proper washing of hands with clean water.
