Date of issue: Monday 29TH NOVEMBER, 2021




Fig 1a. Forecasted seven-day total rainfall for 30th November to 6th December 2021 for Kenya




Fig 2: (a) November 2021 rainfall forecast for Kenya and (b) October 2021 rainfall totals (%)




Fig 3. Observed seven-day weekly rainfall for the period 22-28 November 2021 for Kenya

Experienced Impacts in October 2021

1. Agriculture and Food Security

The continued dry conditions over the ASAL areas have led to insufficient pasture and water for livestock and food for human consumption. Livestock deaths are likely to be reported if the situation does not change. Livestock prices have gone down because they are in bad body condition. A good number of residents could be facing starvation.

2. Disaster Management

Drought has been reported in more than three quarters of Kitui County where most people are faced with acute food shortage.

3. Water Resources Management and Energy

The depressed rainfall received in the ASALs led to continued low levels of water in boreholes, sand wells, sand dams, earth dams and rivers.

Summary

Light to moderate morning rains as well as afternoon and night showers accompanied with thunderstorms are likely to occur over several places from Tuesday this week to Monday next week. Maximum (day time) temperatures are likely to range from 25°C to 30°C while minimum (Night time) temperatures are expected to be between 14°C and 20°C. Strong south-easterly winds with speeds exceeding 25 knots (12.9m/s) and above are expected over several parts of Kitui County.
