

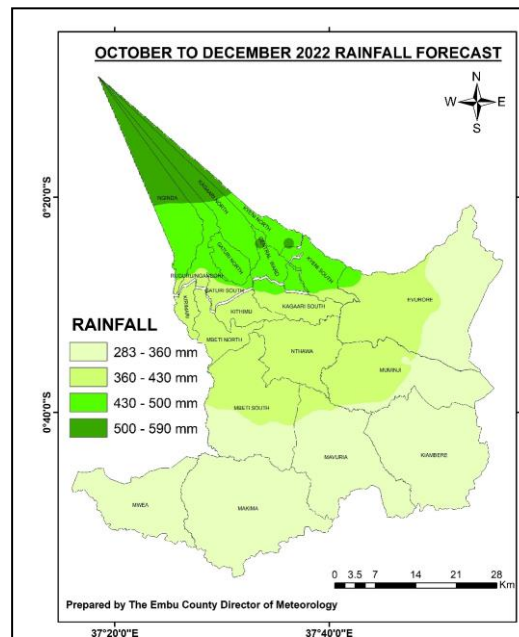

October-November-December (OND) 2022 Rainfall Forecast






























From the National Scale, most parts of Embu County will experience depressed rainfall (Below Normal rainfall). The eastern parts of Mbeere South are expected to experience highly depressed rainfall. Note that the onset of OND rains is predicted to be from 4th week of October to the 1st week of November 2022 and distribution is expected to be poor.




Summary for the Weekly Forecast

During the current forecast period (20th to 26th September 2022), Manyatta and Runyenjes sub-counties in Embu County are expected to experience light wet weather activities over a few places apart from on Friday which will be dry. Monday will get moderate evening showers. Mbeere North and Mbeere South sub-counties are expected to experience light wet weather conditions on Tuesday then from Saturday to Monday but over few paces. Temperatures are expected to be slightly higher than last week throughout the county.
