
KITUI COUNTY

The weather forecast for Kitui County valid: 20th to 26th September 2022

Summary

The County is expected to experience generally dry and partly cloudy conditions breaking into sunny intervals with a chance of light rains over high ground areas towards the end of the forecast period. Maximum temperatures are expected to range from 25°C - 35°C, while minimum temperatures are expected to range from 15°C - 22°C. Farmers are advised to consult the County Ministry of Agriculture officers for appropriate agricultural advisories.
