

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that most places are likely to experience reduction in rainfall amounts. There is likely to be warmer temperatures in most places.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals.
- In the afternoon most places are likely to experience dry conditions. However few places may receive light rain. Towards the end of the forecast period the rain is likely to become moderate and spread to several places.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 27 and 29 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 16 and 17 degrees Celsius.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Reduction in rainfall and warmer temperatures are likely to affect soil moisture content and farmers who depend on rainfall for crop production are urged to adjust their farming schedules.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.
