



Period of forecast: Tuesday 1st April to Monday 7th April 2025

Summary

Kisumu County will receive light to moderate rainfall amounts especially towards the end of this forecast period. The light/moderate afternoon/night showers will occur over few to many places accompanied by thunderstorms. The day-time and night-time temperatures will increase during the period. During the next week, the forecast indicates that Kisumu County will receive significant rainfall amounts.
