Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Summary

This week's forecast indicates that several places are likely to receive light to moderate rainfall. There is a likelihood that both day and night time temperatures will slightly increase in several places.

- In the morning, several places are likely to experience sunny intervals.
- In the afternoon several places are likely to experience moderate rainfall during the first half of the forecast period. Thereafter the rainfall will reduce.
- At night most places are likely to be partly cloudy.
- Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 26 and 28 degrees Celsius.
- Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 15 and 17 degrees Celsius.

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Harvest rain water whenever it rains.
- Do not walk in the open or seek shelter under trees when it is raining in order to avoid being struck by lightning.
- Since rainfall in the coming week is expected to reduce significantly, this will be a good opportunity to carry out weeding for those that use conventional methods.
- Users are advised that this is a forecast and at times there may be discrepancies between forecast estimates and actual amounts of rainfall received.

Advice to farmers from Ministry of Agriculture:

- Consult your agricultural extension officer for advice in line with this forecast.
