Tuesday 31st March 2025 to **Monday** 7th April 2025

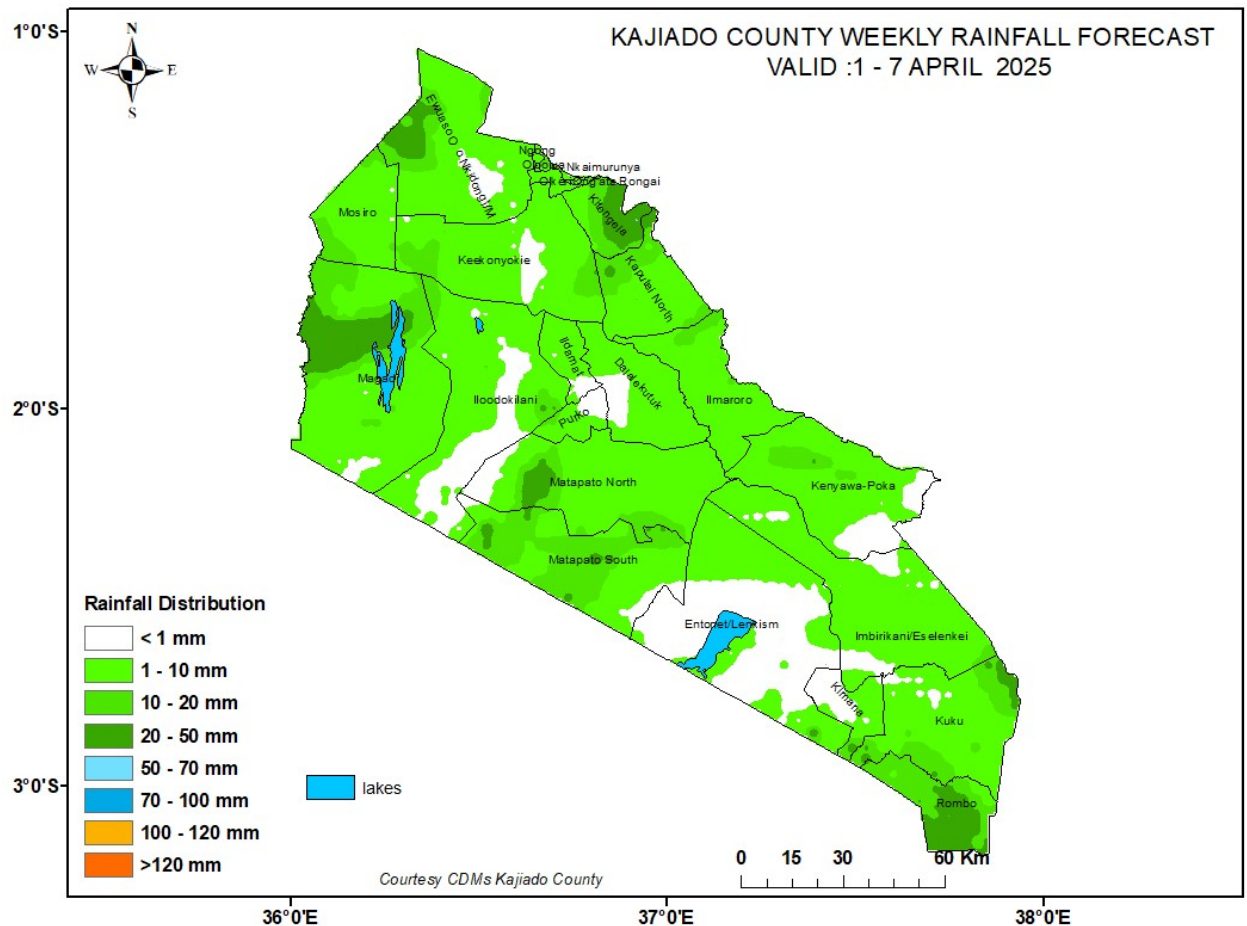
General outlook for the week:

✓ Rainfall expected to continue over several places during the forecast period with a significant decrease in the rainfall amounts and spatial coverage

✓ Winds: to experience moderate South Easterly / Easterly / North easterly breeze at about (3 - 6 m/s)

Temperature:

✓ The maximum temperature expected to be high over the period ranges is **24-31°C** and the minimum **15 - 21°C**.

➤ Key to rainfall distribution symbols: No rain likely to fall, rain likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain likely to fall in several places (33% -67%), rain likely to fall in most places (more than 67%): **Green** – No weather-related hazards are expected; **Amber** Thunderstorms & lightning

Commentary of County Weather forecaster:

1. Rainfall expected to continue over several places during the forecast period with a significant decrease in the rainfall amounts and spatial coverage
2. A cool day time and night time temperatures are expected to range from 15 – 31°C
3. Winds: Some areas shall experience moderate South Easterly / Easterly / North easterly breeze at 3 - 6 m/s.
4. Expert advice be obtained from the Agriculture, Livestock, Veterinary, Public Health and Education offices, among others and take advantage of the prevailing and expected conditions.
