FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY TOTAL RAINFALL FOR 15TH TO 21ST APRIL 2025

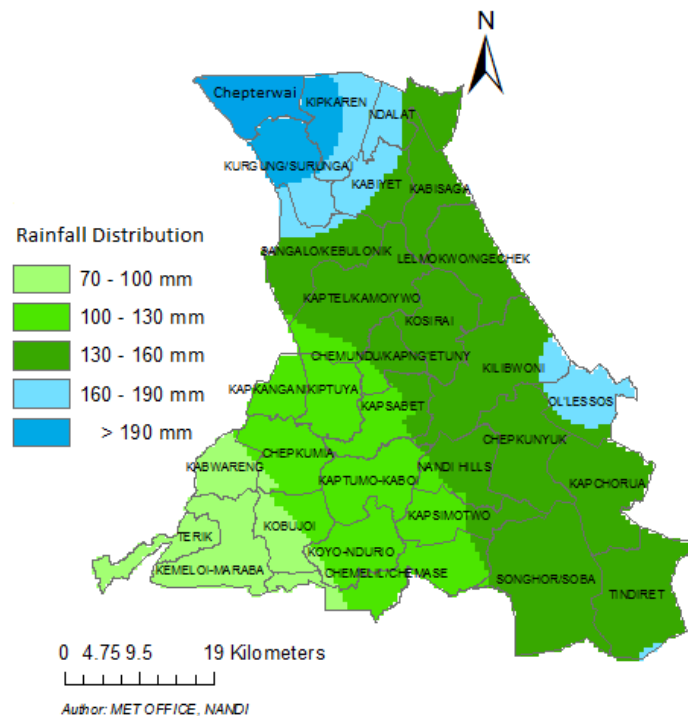


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 15th to 21st April 2025

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals expected during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Moderate rains are expected during the forecast period, covering most places on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and many places on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions expected in few days of the focussed period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 26-27°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 14°-15°C during the forecast period.
