FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY RAINFALL FOR 1ST TO 7TH APRIL 2025

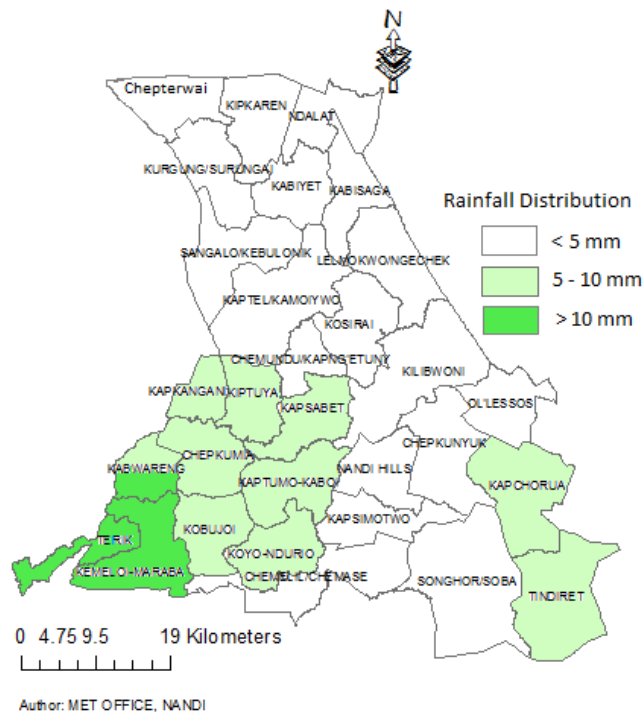


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 1st to 7th April 2025
































Date of issue: Monday 31st March 2025

General Outlook/Summary.

Rainfall is expected to continue over many parts of the county during the forecast period. However a decrease in rainfall is expected as compared to previous week (24th-30th Mar 2025)

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals expected during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Light to moderate rains are expected during the forecast period. Light rainfall covering few places is expected Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Moderate rainfall covering many places likely to be experienced on Saturday, Sunday and Monday.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions expected in few days of the focussed period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 27-28°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 14°-15°C during the forecast period.
