Date of issue: Tuesday 22nd April, 2025




Figure 1: Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast

The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 22nd to 28th April, 2025.

Several wards are likely to be wet as depicted above on figure.1. They are likely to receive light to moderate rains in the morning showers and thunderstoms afternoon and night during the forecast period.

Rainfall distribution – no places.

Green – No weather-related hazards are expected

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms over few areas during the course of the forecast period

- Morning light rains as well as afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are likely to occur over several areas
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 27.0°C and 32.0°C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 17.0°C and 19.0°C

The weather outlook for the week of 28th April to 6th May, 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience wet weather conditions over several areas
