

Key to rainfall distribution symbols: Train is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), rain is likely to fall inmany places (33% -67%), rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

The weather outlook for the week of 22nd – 28th April 2025, indicates some moderate to low rainfall activities within the County of Trans Nzoia

The forecast details are as follows:

- The morning sessions are expected to experience sunny intervals.
- During the afternoon sessions, light rains confined to few places will be experienced most of the days except on Wednesday where moderate rains covering several places will be experienced; and on Sunday and Monday which are forecasted to have sunny intervals. The rest of the afternoons are forecasted to have moderate rains covering several places.
- The nights are expected to be have cloudy conditions.

The weather outlook for the week of 29th April - 5th May 2025, indicates that Trans Nzoia County is likely to experience a slight reduction of rainfall activities over most places.
