WEATHER FORECAST FOR THE NEXT SEVEN DAYS VALID 6 – 12 May, 2025

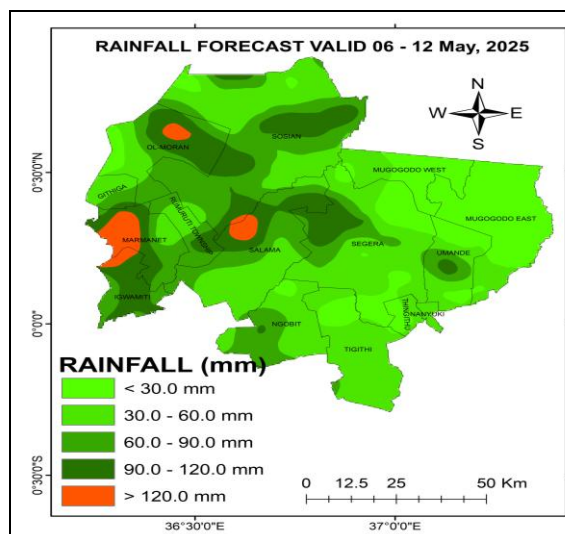
Forecast for the next Seven days (6 – 12 May, 2025) indicates;

- Rainfall expected over most places
- Moderate to heavy afternoon showers and thunderstorms are likely over several places
- The Maximum temperatures expected to range between 20 - 30°C and the (Minimum) temperatures to range 06 - 20°C

Review of weather for the last seven-days (29 Apr – 05 May, 2025)

- Light to Moderate amounts of rainfall were observed over Few places including Ol Pejeta, Kinamba Nanyuki, Daiga, Rumuruti etc
- *Comparing the last two weeks the precipitation amounts decreased.*
- Both the day time (Max) temperatures and the Night time (Min) temperatures increased

Expected Rainfall Distribution for the Next Seven Days (6 – 12 May, 2025)



Expect cloudy/light rains in the morning over few places, afternoon showers and thunderstorms sometimes extending to the night over several places

Between 10.0 mm – 120.0 mm of cumulated weekly rainfall is likely as indicated in the adjacent rainfall forecast map.

Much of the predicted rains are due in the first half of the forecasting period

➤ **TS – Thunderstorms; AWS - Automatic Weather Station**

➤ **Further outlook indicates that the season rains are expected to continue in the month of May, 2025.**

➤ **Risk of flash floods in the lower areas & strong winds that may cause tree breakage or blow off the house roofs etc**

➤ **On average the daily Maximum and Minimum temperatures are expected to reduce due to cloudiness and showery precipitation over several places**

< 5 mm	Light	TERMs	MEANING
5 – 20 mm	Moderate	Most places	Between 67% and 100%
20 – 50 mm	Heavy	Several Places	Between 33% and 67%
> 50 mm	Very heavy	Few places	Below 33%
