


Figure 1: Migori Climatic Zones




Figure 2: 7day cumulative rainfall forecast valid 13-19 May 2025




Figure 3: Maximum Temperature forecast 13-19 May 2025

The county will continue to receive rainfall during the first half of the forecast period. Central and eastern sector of the county are expected to receive the highest weekly cumulative rainfall. Most parts of Kuria west and east sub counties expected to receive more than 50mm (Figure 2).




Figure 4: Minimum Temperature Forecast 13-19 May 2025

The day-time and night time temperatures during the period are as shown in Figure 3 and 4.

- Daytime temperatures are expected to range from 21°C to 26°C and night time temperatures to range from 14°C to 17°C.



Commentary of County Weather forecaster:

- Sunny intervals are expected in the morning though occasional rains may occur over places during the first half of the forecast period. Afternoon showers and thunderstorms are likely to occur over several places during the first half of the forecast period. The spatial coverage will however reduce to few places during the second half of the forecast period. Nights are expected to be partly cloudy though occasional showers may occur over few places.
- Daytime temperatures are expected to range from 22°C to 27°C and night time temperatures to range from 16°C to 21°C.



Weather Review for 5th to 11th May 2025

- > Rainfall continued over the county during the review period.
- Lela AWS Rainfall station recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 120.4mm while Nyakweri AWS (64.0mm) recorded the highest amount within 24-hour period of 62.8mm on 7th May 2025. Other stations that recorded significant rainfalls are Koromangucha (55.6mm); Migori Dept' of Environment (115.7mm); Miyare (86.7mm); Migori Dept' of Env. (75.3mm); Kuna (70.8mm); Sony Sugar (68.4mm) while the rest of the stations recorded less than 65mm.
